Questions for Personal Reflection and Group Discussion

1. Read Luke 23:55-24:12.

What were the women planning to do at Jesus' tomb on Sunday morning, and what did they find when they arrived?

Read Luke 9:22, 44 and 18:31-34. What had Jesus told His followers?

Why is it important to remember God's word, especially in times of distress?

How did the disciples respond to what the women told them? Imagine yourself in the story. How would you have reacted to the news that Jesus' body was no longer in the grave?

2. Read Luke 24:13-34.

Jesus appeared to two men on the road to Emmaus. Why would Jesus have the two men tell Him about events He already knew about?

Who had the men hoped Jesus would be? How did Jesus help them put the pieces together?

When the men finally recognized Jesus, what were they compelled to do after He disappeared?

Again, put yourself in the story. Would you have recognized Jesus? How do you think you would have responded when you realized He was with you?

3. Read Luke 24:35-48.

What was the reaction of the disciples when Jesus appeared among them? How did Jesus demonstrate that He was not just a spirit, but had a real, physical resurrected body?

What does the truth of Jesus' resurrection teach you about who He is and what He has done for you?

How has Jesus revealed Himself to you? How has the truth of His death and resurrection impacted your life?
