

Questions for Personal Reflection and Group Discussion

1. Read Isaiah 43:18-19.

Take some time to consider the different areas of your life. What new thing do you long for God to do in you in 2024?

Spend some time praying or journaling through your goals, resolutions, hopes or dreams for 2024. Invite God to do His work in those areas of your life.

Now, what if God's plans for you are different than what you have in mind? How might you respond? Pray or journal through that possibility.

2. Read Psalm 145:4-7.

What stories do you have to tell of God's work in your life? How have you experienced His power and greatness?

With whom are you sharing the story of God's goodness to you? Who needs to hear what God is doing in you?

3. Read Mark 12:30-31.

What does Jesus identify as the greatest commandment?

In what ways do you need to grow in loving God with all your heart, soul, mind and strength? What step of growth will you take this year?

4. Read Psalm 147:11 and Isaiah 40:31.

What does the word 'fear' mean in Psalm 147:11?

Where or in whom do you really put your trust?

What does Isaiah say will happen to those who put their trust in God? Do these words describe you? If not, why not?

How could you grow in trusting God's love for you this year?

What kind of story do you want to be able to tell when you reach the end of 2024?
