Questions for Personal Reflection and Group Discussion

1. Read Hebrews 3:1-6 and Ephesians 2:19-22.

How is Jesus greater than Moses?

In this passage, Jesus is identified as being both God's messenger and High Priest. What was the role of God's messengers (prophets) and the High Priest in the Old Testament? How is Jesus uniquely qualified to fulfill both roles?

What does it mean to you to be part of "God's house?"

2. Read Hebrews 3:7-19 and John 14:27.

What kinds of things cause you to doubt, grumble or complain in your relationship with God? In what areas are you reluctant to take Him at His word?

5. Read Hebrews 4:1-6.

What kind of 'rest' is the author of Hebrews referring to in these verses?

What keeps people from experiencing this rest?

Are you experiencing the rest of God in your life? If not, what keeps you from it?

6. Read Hebrews 4:7-11.

In what ways would you like to have more rest in your spiritual life? What could you do to help make that happen?

What about this world will you most look forward to resting from in heaven?

7. Read Hebrews 4:12-13.

In what ways have you experienced the Word of God being alive and powerful in your life?

How are you allowing God's Word to do its work in your heart, mind, and daily living?
