Questions for Personal Reflection and Group Discussion

1. Read Hebrews 4:14-16.

Verse 14 is short, but rich with truth. Write out, in your own words what this verse means. How does it encourage you to hold tightly to your faith?

What does it mean to you that Jesus understands your weaknesses and struggles? What encouragement do you find in knowing that He experienced the same temptations that you do?

What does 'come boldly to the throne of grace' mean? Do you approach God with confidence? Why or why not?

2. Read Hebrews 5:1-6.

In what ways have you tried to represent yourself to God rather than letting Jesus do that?

What do you learn about the character of Jesus in these verses?

3. Read Hebrews 5:7-10.

Imagine Jesus praying to His Father as verse 7 describes. How was His prayer life like yours? How was it different?

In what ways do you interact with Jesus as your High Priest? As your King?

Why was it necessary for Jesus to learn obedience through suffering? What did it accomplish?

How has God brought something good out of the suffering in your life?
