### **Questions for Personal Reflection and Group Discussion**

# 1. Read Hebrews 9:1-10.

What features of the Old Testament tabernacle and system of worship stand out to you and why?

As a dwelling place for God, what were the limitations of the tabernacle?

How would your life be different if your access to God was limited or restricted in the same way the Israelites was?

### 2. Read Hebrews 9: 11-15.

What benefits of the New Covenant do you find listed in these verses? Which phrases stand out to you and why?

How is the way we worship today different because of Christ's sacrifice?

## 3. Read Hebrews 9:16-22.

God gave very detailed instructions for the building and furnishing of the tabernacle in the Old Testament (see Exodus chapters 25-30). Then He instructed that everything be sprinkled with blood. Why?

What important truths do you see in this contrast between beauty and blood?

# 4. Read Hebrews 9:23-28.

Instead of covering your sin, Christ's blood cleanses you from sin. How is that significant to you?

Does this passage change the way you think about the unprecedented access that you as a Christ-follower have to God? What does 'confidence' to come into the presence of God look like (or not look like) for you?
