Questions for Personal Reflection and Group Discussion

In what areas of your life do you have relationships or interactions with people who don't yet know Jesus?

1. Read Mark 4:26-29.

What does the farmer do in this story?

What is the responsibility of the farmer? What is not his responsibility?

With this story, what is Jesus illustrating about our responsibility in sharing the gospel?

How does this align with or differ from your understanding of what it means to share Jesus with others?

2. Read Matthew 5:16.

What is it that Jesus says we are to let shine out? Who should see them? Why should they see them?

How are you displaying the love of God in your everyday, ordinary life? What do people see in your actions or attitude that points to Him?

3. Read Colossians 4:5-6.

What do you think Paul means when he says to "live wisely" and why does it matter?

What kind of opportunities do you think Paul is talking about here? What opportunities has God given you to point people to Him? How will you do that this week?

4. Read Galatians 5:13.

What are we to use our freedom in Christ for?

What has God already given you that you could use to serve someone else and love them like Jesus would?

5. Read 1 Corinthians 3:6-7.

Pastor Chris said, "Our role is not to produce fruit. Our role is to be faithful." How does this help to reshape your perspective on what evangelism is?

Think of one person in your world who doesn't know Jesus yet. What will you do this week to gently point them to Him?
