You don't see yourself joining at least one of the LGBTQ+ or intersectional organizations on campus.




There is almost no overlap between athletics and the LGBTQ+ community.




Bathrooms on campus are a huge conversation topic. Bathrooms shouldn't just be there... they should be easy.




They don't offer LGBTQ+ housing options, such as an LGBTQ+ living-learning community (LLC) or a roommate-matching service to connect students to an LGBTQ-friendly roommate.




You can't find explicit LGBTQ+ language in mission statements, nondiscrimination policies, and other policies.



There aren't many out LGBTQ+ faculty and staff.




You don't see any pride symbols around campus except at the LGBTQ+ Center.



You meet the LGBTQ+ Center director, but you don't feel much of a connection.



The health center doesn't seem aware or helpful about LGBTQ+ health topics.
