Your Waterfront License with Vancouver Fraser Port Authority Zoom Meeting

Your Immediate Action is Requested

A member of the Alderside Residents Committee requested to meet with Jennifer Natland today in the Port of Vancouver offices to present our request for clarity from the Port about their Zoom meeting this Thursday evening August 24 at 6:30 pm.

A meeting was denied and after over an hour of waiting, our member was met by a combative and dismissive Katarina Stoyko who advised that there would be no meeting with Ms. Natland.

Our committee is asking that all stakeholders send an email to Jennifer Natland (jennifer.natland@portvancouver.com) as follows:

Dear Ms. Natland:

I am concerned over the proposed new license agreements that the Port is considering for new and existing docks and reclaimed land and would ask that you specifically address the following points in your Zoom meeting this Thursday:

- 1) Why the proposed changes to our existing licenses?
- 2) What is the plan after 2040 / 41?
- 3) Why is there no transferability of this contract if we were to sell?
- 4) Will homeowners be reimbursed for the constructive expropriation of the waterfront property?
- 5) Why not pause this proposal for 24 months so both parties can find an amenable solution?
