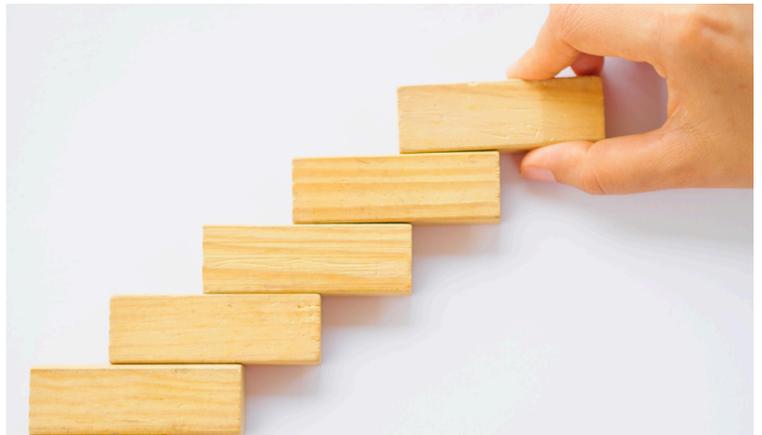

THE EXACT PROCESS – 4 MEETING FRAMEWORK

WITH DETAILED PRE-WORK & POST-WORK STEPS

Meeting 1: Foundation & Timeline Strategy

Goal: Establish client expectations, assess timeline feasibility, finalize a right-fit list, and launch the process quickly.



Pre-Work (Student):

- Complete WORX Self-Inventory (Module 2)
- Upload unofficial transcript and test scores (Module 2)
- Submit initial draft of college list (from any previous research or none at all)
- Fill out student profile and communication preferences
- Review Meeting Protocol Overview

During Meeting:

- Review list and discuss priorities (geography, size, selectivity, institutional type)
- Clarify short-term goals (UC only? ED/EA? Max number of apps?)
- Introduce App Tracker tool (Module 5)
- Assign College Research Task (Module 4)

Meeting 2: Application Strategy & Logistics

Goal: Map out submission strategy, organize requirements, and ensure materials are in progress.



Pre-Work (Student):

- Update App Tracker with deadlines and application types (ED/EA/RA/UC)
- Begin requesting letters of recommendation
- Input recommenders into portals (if available)
- Begin completing Common App or UC activities section (Module 5)

During Meeting:

- Review application strategy + deadlines
- Confirm recommendation requests and testing requirements
- Discuss essay timeline and writing preferences
- Identify supplements required for each school
- Assign pre-writing task or refer to Prompt (Module 7 & 8)

Post-Work (Student):

- Upload LOR confirmation dates in tracker
- Identify and copy all required supplemental prompts
- Complete Your World Organizer (Module 8) or UC PIQ prewriting
- Confirm testing (SAT/ACT) or select “test-optional” where applicable

Meeting 3: Essay & Content Development

Goal: Launch personal statement and supplements with strong alignment to the student's voice and timeline.



Pre-Work (Student):

- Share preferred essay idea or prompt
- Provide any previously written drafts (if applicable)

During Meeting:

- Review brainstorm and outline draft direction
- Assign essay development or refer to Prompt coach
- Clarify tone, narrative arc, and structure expectations
- Discuss how supplements align with core narrative

Post-Work (Student):

- Draft Common App essay or UC PIQs (Module 8)
- Submit for review/feedback
- Draft top-priority school supplements
- Review portal instructions for writing submissions

- Conduct live walk-through of each application portal

- Submit all ready applications
- Send thank-you emails to recommenders
- Save login credentials + submission confirmations
- Begin portal follow-up, interview prep (if applicable)

- Long-term strategy (FAFSA, interviews = optional add-ons)
