SNAPSHOT: ACCELERATED MEDICAL ASSISTANT PROGRAM

PROGRAM DETAILS

The Medical Assistant Program is a 4-month (16-week), 500-hour hybrid course offered in a combination of online asynchronous learning, in-person skills practice, and clinical externship. The program includes 24-60 hours of hands-on training at LA or Sacramento locations and an 80-hour clinical experience. Accredited by the BPPE, graduates are eligible to take the Certified Clinical Medical Assistant (CCMA) exam through the NHA, with study materials provided. Prerequisites include Medical Terminology from NHA and enrollment requires an application and orientation. Upon completion, students earn a Certificate of Completion and eligibility for the NHA CCMA licensure exam.

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS AND DISCLOSURES

This program requires that students submit their proof of immunization, TB test, general wellness physical, and fingerprint by week 3 of the Program

List of vaccinations and health screenings:

- 2 x MMR (Measles, Mumps & Rubella) or titer immunity
- 2 x Varicella (chickenpox) or titer immunity
- 3 x Hepatitis B or titer immunity
- General wellness physical
- 2 x Covid 19 (Proof of injections -NOTE: there is a 3-week gap needed between the 1st and 2nd immunization) and booster.
 - Covid Booster- Scholars may need to have additional boosters nearing the time of their externship.
 - *Do allow covid declination for personal, medical, or religious exemption
 - Signed McKallen Medical Training form needed.
- One Step PPD (TB) or blood titer showing non-infection –
 - This will likely not be required until nearing your externship start date (typically within 12 months). This is either a one or two step PPD Mantoux test, blood titer or chest Xray.
- Flu shot or can decline Flu shot (McKallen will provide declination form)
- Proof of car insurance or health insurance (Per clinical request)

Please note: All scholars may be asked to show proof of immunizations required by the clinical sites and some programs with onsite coursework prior to enrollment or an externship.

EXTERNSHIP DISCLOSURES

Please note that an externship is an integral part of program completion and scholars will need to adhere to the following McKallen Medical Training Externship requirements:

- Signed student clinical contract.
- Always listening to what the clinical instructor needs & expects daily.
- Being respectful and professional to instructors, facility staff and residents, and classmates.

PROGRAM AND LAB SCHEDULES

The Medical Assistant Program consists of 16 weeks of in-person & online training with bi-weekly hands-on skill labs and clinicals. Asynchronous course work is due weekly, including lectures, quizzes, chapter reading, and workbook assignments.

- Live Zoom Lectures: 1-2 days a week
- In Person Skill Lab (Weeks 10,14, & 16)
 - 3.5hrs
- Asynchronous Virtual Skill Lab (Weeks 11,12 & 15)
- BLS (Week 2)
 - 90 min course
- Clinicals (Week 10 – 16) *Based on clinical partner preference @ Medical Clinic
 - 2X a week from 9 AM – 2:30 PM (Monday – Friday)

ENROLLMENT DISCLOSURES

After successful registration for the course, McKallen Medical Training will require the following:

- In person or virtual interview with a staff/ faculty member to go over course expectations to ensure success.
