Role of the Parent Liaison:

Responsibilities of the Parent Liaison:

- Collaborate with the LG Administration.
- Be available to LG families who have questions.
- Assist parents in connecting with the correct person to obtain needed information.
- Respond to emails received.
- Provide a report to the BOD as needed.
- Share all information/emails received with the BOD.
- Will not encourage parents to side with a particular viewpoint
- Will not encourage parents to join any group that is not sanctioned by the school.
- Regularly attend BOD meetings.
- Maintain confidentiality.
- Be a proud supporter of the School, the BOD, and the Administration.
