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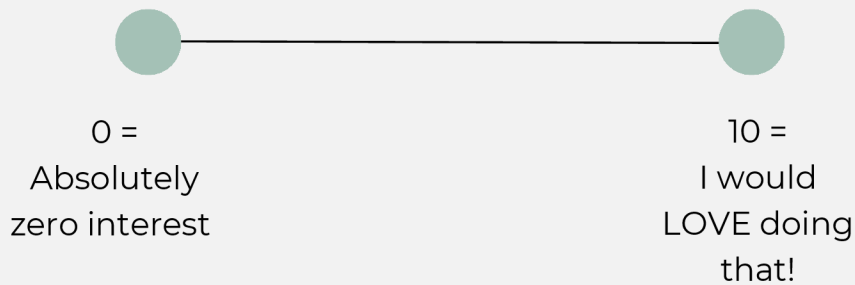

Curriculum & Instructional Design Roles

INSTRUCTIONAL DESIGNER

An Instructional Designer creates engaging learning materials and resources for learners of all ages and training resources for adult learners. They use pedagogical knowledge and frameworks like backward design to achieve learning outcomes. Teachers excel here because lesson planning, pedagogical knowledge, and helping learners achieve learning objectives directly translate into designing effective learning resources. If you enjoy creating content, mapping learning objectives, and making complex topics clear, you'll likely thrive in this role. In the Become a Curriculum & Instructional Designer course, you'll gain these skills, earn certification with university master's-level credit, and be personally mentored by experts already working in instructional design.

Curriculum & Instructional Design Roles Cont.

CURRICULUM DESIGNER / DEVELOPER

Curriculum Designers develop instructional materials, courses, or programs, often aligning them to standards or specific outcomes. Teachers love this work because it allows them to continue shaping learning experiences without managing a classroom, and they bring a deep understanding of how curriculum impacts learners. If you enjoy writing lessons, aligning objectives to activities, and designing effective learning resources, you'd likely fit well here. The Become a Curriculum & Instructional Designer course also gives you opportunities to hear directly from hiring companies about what it's like to work in these roles.

E-LEARNING DEVELOPER

E-Learning Developers build interactive online courses and modules, often using e-learning programs and tools. Teachers who enjoy technology and creative design thrive here, especially if they like experimenting with visuals, simulations, or gamification. If you love pairing your teaching knowledge with tech tools to make learning fun and accessible, this role could be ideal. LEARNING EXPERIENCE DESIGNER (LXD)

If you enjoy designing with empathy, creativity, and strategy, this could be a strong fit. 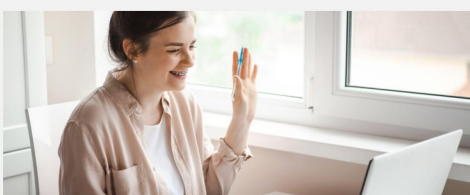
Customer Success / Educational Success Roles

CUSTOMER SUCCESS MANAGER

Would you enjoy working for an education company and being the main contact with a school or district? Would you enjoy helping them be successful with the educational resources they have purchased with the company? A Customer Success Manager (CSM) is the main relationship person or liaison between education companies and the schools. They build relationships with clients to ensure they succeed with a product or service. Teachers and administrators excel here because they are dedicated to helping others and ensuring they succeed — skills that easily translate to supporting clients. The Become a Customer Success Specialist course certifies you in this work, helps you earn university credit, and provides personal mentoring from experts already working as CSMs.

ACCOUNT MANAGER

Would you enjoy being the long-term relationship partner for schools, districts, or companies that purchase resources? Account Managers focus on maintaining those partnerships, ensuring renewals, and sometimes helping organizations expand their use of services or products. Teachers and administrators thrive here because they are strong at building trust, listening closely, and communicating value in ways that support long-term success. If you like connecting with people and being the steady point of contact that clients can rely on, this role may be a great fit. Training & Educational Consulting / Professional Development Roles

Teachers and administrators love this role because it lets them continue influencing classrooms without teaching full-time, and they often feel energized by coaching peers. If you enjoy leading PD sessions, mentoring, and helping other teachers grow, you'll thrive here. CORPORATE TRAINER

Corporate Trainers design and deliver training sessions for employees in business settings, often on compliance, professional skills, and technical systems. Teachers and administrators thrive here because they are already skilled at presenting, managing groups, and breaking down information. If you enjoy facilitating workshops and want to expand your audience from kids to adults, this could be a perfect fit. 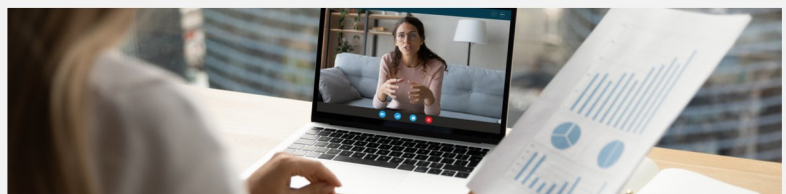
Training & Educational Consulting / Professional Development Roles Cont.

Educational Consultants advise schools, districts, or companies on curriculum, instructional strategies, or product adoption. If you like coaching, guiding big-picture changes, and shaping how schools or organizations improve, this could be a strong fit. 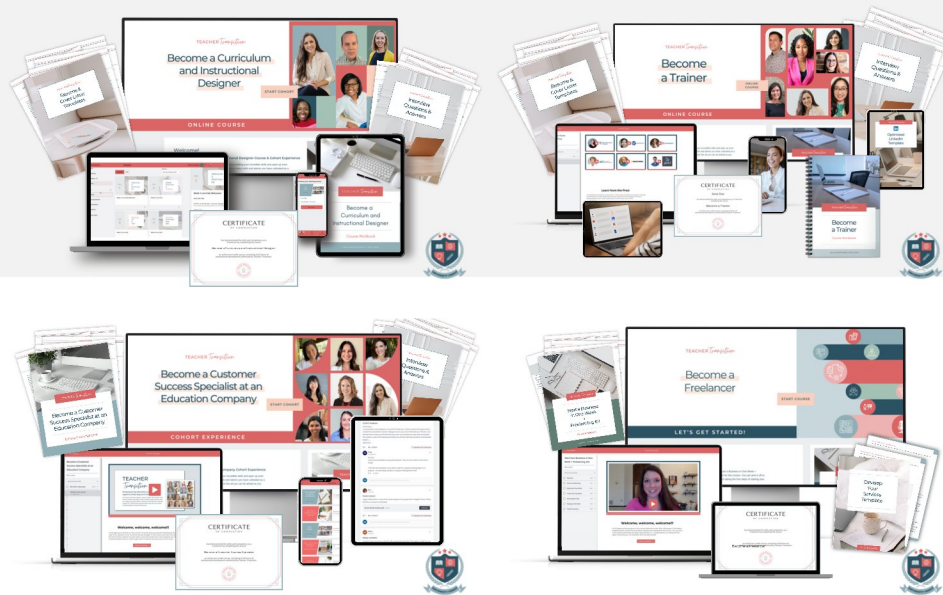
