
### **The Grange Gallery**



## Smugglers in The Deans...



### ■ Brandy, Beacons & Bold Deeds: The Smugglers of the Deans

Long before Saltdean Lido and Brighton buses, the Deans were a smuggler's paradise. In the 17th and 18th centuries, these quiet chalk valleys were alive with whispers, lanterns and the clink of contraband. With secluded coves, hidden cliff gaps and winding lanes leading inland, this stretch of coast was perfect for the lucrative business of "free trade."

### Rottingdean — Where Half the Village Ran the Brandy:

Rottingdean was the beating heart of Sussex smuggling. The gap in the cliffs offered a ready-made landing spot for small boats gliding in under moonlight, holds packed with tea, lace, wine and brandy — and sometimes wool being snuck *out* to France.

Beneath the cobbled streets, a **network of tunnels** is said to link the seafront with old cottages and pubs, including **Ye Olde Black Horse Inn** and the former **Customs House**. The pub cellars made perfect hiding places for a few "extra barrels," and it's said that if you listen closely, you can still feel the hum of mischief in the walls.

The **Rottingdean Windmill** on Beacon Hill wasn't just for grinding grain — locals swore its sails once turned in secret code, signalling to waiting ships that the excise men had gone to bed.

Even the great **Rudyard Kipling**, who lived in the village, was charmed by the tales. His poem *A Smuggler's Song* ("Five and twenty ponies, trotting through the dark...") was inspired by these very hills.

And if you've ever heard of **John "Smoker" Mills**, Rottingdean's most notorious 18th-century smuggler, you'll know why the locals both feared and admired him — he could outrun a customs officer and outdrink a sailor before breakfast!

#### Saltdean — The Quiet Accomplice:

A little east along the cliffs, **Saltdean Gap** provided the perfect stage for unloading cargo unseen. Under cover of darkness, kegs were rolled ashore, hoisted up the cliffs, and spirited over the Downs by pack ponies. Local women hid silk beneath their petticoats and men disguised brandy barrels under straw.

#### Ovingdean and Beyond — The Green Lanes of Secrecy:

Though smaller, **Ovingdean** and its inland neighbours played their part too. Farmhands and shepherds acted as lookouts or storage hosts, guiding the smuggled goods inland along the old "**Green Lanes of Sussex**." These paths — now peaceful walking routes — were once busy midnight highways for contraband.

The smuggling years left more than just stories — they shaped the character of the Deans. Every pub, lane and cliff seems to hold a secret, and every whisper of the wind on Beacon Hill sounds faintly like the echo of hooves carrying brandy through the dark.


### **Holly Crompton**
