

# 12 PUPPY TIPS

## FOR PROOFING YOUR HOME



### Use Baby Gates

Install baby gates to block off areas you don't want your puppy to access, such as stairs or certain rooms.



### Secure Loose Cables

Hide or cover electrical cords and cables to prevent your puppy from chewing on them.



### Small Objects

Ensure small items like coins, batteries, and buttons are not left lying around. They can be choking hazards.



### Create a Safe Space

Designate a specific area as your puppy's safe zone, with a cozy bed, toys, and water.



### Inspect for Gaps

Check for and block any small gaps under furniture where your puppy could crawl in and get stuck.



### Trash Can Security

Use pet-proof trash cans or secure lids to prevent your puppy from rummaging through garbage.



### **House Plants Safety**

Ensure house plants are non-toxic to pets and place them out of reach. Some indoor plants can be harmful if ingested.



### **Lock Windows & Doors**

Always keep windows, balcony doors, and any potentially dangerous exits securely locked.



### **Chew Toys**

Provide plenty of chew toys to keep your puppy occupied and to deter chewing on furniture and other household items.



### **Store Hazardous Items**

Keep cleaning supplies, medications, and other toxic substances out of reach, preferably in locked cabinets.



### **Cover Sharp Edges**

Use corner guards or edge covers on furniture with sharp edges to prevent your puppy from getting injured.



### **Secure Toiletries**

Keep bathroom doors closed or secure your toiletries, as items like razors, soap, and personal care products can be hazardous.
