As a DCS/DHHS employee, your paycheck comes from Federal Incentive Payments awarded to each state based on specific performance metrics under Social Security Act Title IV-D Section 458:

Paternity establishment rate
Child support order enforcement
Current support payment compliance
Arrearage collection performance
Cost-effectiveness in enforcement
Family courts determine how much time
a child spends with each parent, directly
influencing child support payments. Less
parenting time means higher child
support payments—boosting federal
incentives received by the state.
This system financially benefits from
limiting a child's relationship with a
loving parent.
