Enrollments: Enrollment process held September 1 - September 30, Program starts the 4th Saturday in October. All youth are encouraged to participate. All denominations are welcome. No application is refuse. Application is to determine how to structure the program and establish the size of a meeting room.

Activities/ Literatures: Group discusses, Pamphlets, Seminars, Workshops, Fun Activities such as Bowling, Skating, Cook-out, etc.
