LET'S BE REAL

BEFORE YOU LEAVE...

	Vet check (are vaccines, meds, and records up to date?)
	Flea/tick prevention packed?
	Refill prescriptions or supplements (add 3 extra days just in case)
	Upload photos of your dog to your phone (ID, emergency use)
	GPS tag or updated ID tag on collar?



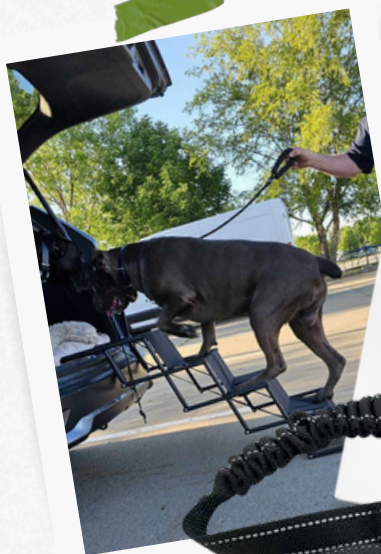
GEAR CHECK

	Big Ass Harness & Leash
	Identification w/ rabies tag
	Waste bags (lots of 'em)
	Travel food & water bowls
	Big Ass Adventure Pack for carrying supplies
	Favorite toys or chew for calming on the road



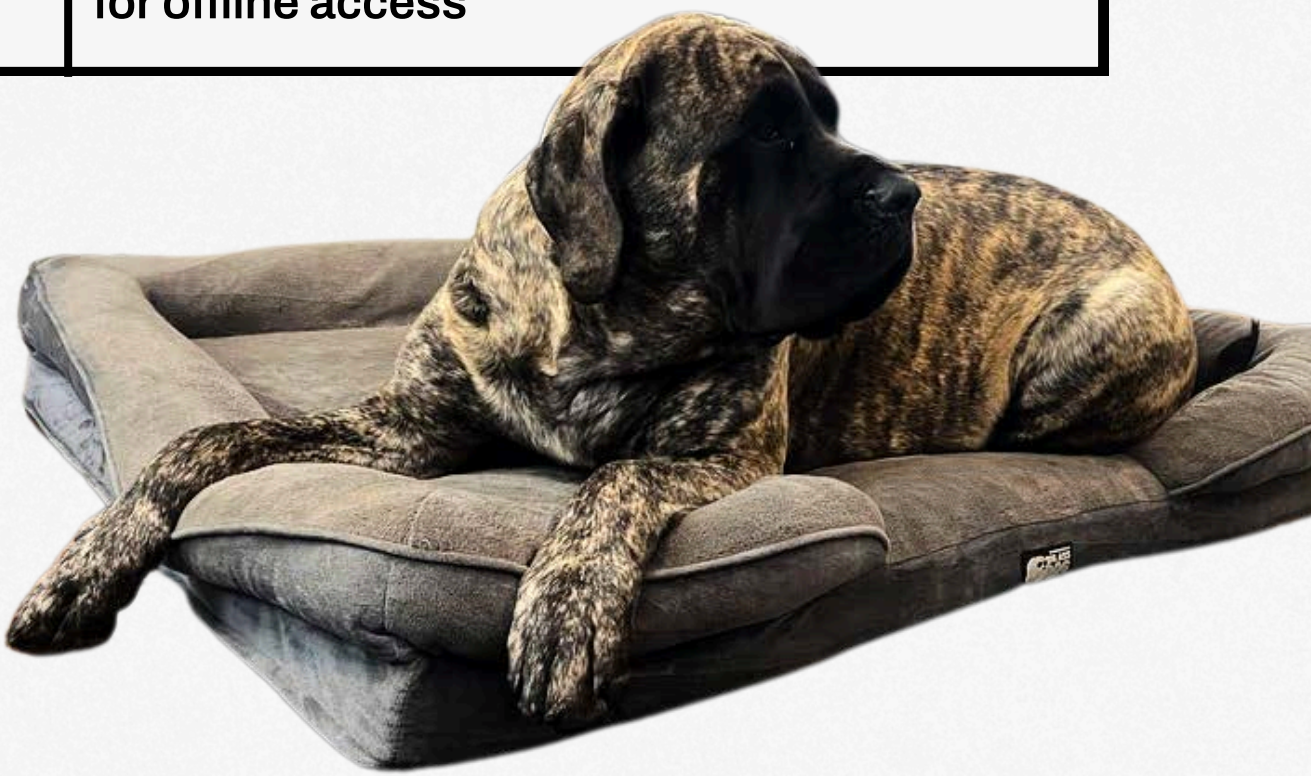
VEHICLE PREP

	Safety Restraint: Harness to seatbelt clip or secured crate
	Big Ass Steps or ramp for easy entry/exit
	Waterproof seat cover or cargo liner
	Portable fan or cooling mat (especially for senior dogs)
	Emergency cleaner (drool, puke, whatever happens)
	Towels (drool, puddles, beach visits, etc.)
	Extra leash tucked in glove box
	Travel water jug



ACCOMMODATIONS & PLANNING

	Confirm pet-friendly lodging
	Look for ground-floor rooms or private entry when possible
	BringFido or AllTrails app for dog-friendly activities
	Know where the nearest vet or emergency clinic is
	Pack Big Ass Bolster Bed or sleeping pad from home for comfort
	Print or save reservation emails for offline access



ON-THE-ROAD ESSENTIALS



	Long leash or tie-out
	Poop bags (seriously, always bring more)
	Backup food in case you can't find your brand
	Treats for good behavior and distractions
	Cooling bandana or jacket for hot days
	Jacket or blanket for chilly nights
	First-aid kit dog-safe antiseptic, wraps, Benadryl*)
	Copy of vaccine records or rabies certificate
