Sunrise Lodge takes great pride in being an American Plan Resort allowing you to sit back and enjoy the great food, accommodations, and activities. The real beauty of Sunrise Lodge can be found outside your cabin whether it be Dick's famous landscaping and flowers, nature's spectacular show near the lakefront, or our delicious breakfast and dinner! The main lodge is where the "Sunrise Experience" all comes together. The recreation room features free games such as pool, ping-pong, foosball, and air hockey. The TV room has movies, games and books for your rainy day enjoyment. The main lodge at Sunrise is a gathering place for early morning coffee, to meet for the next activity, or to relax after dinner with your fellow guests.



Driftwood is a popular three bedroom unit which allows you to enjoy the beautiful sunrise in the morning and cuddle up in front of the gas fireplace on a cool evening. All units at Sunrise have fireplaces (whether they are wood burning or gas).



Executive 1 (pictured above) is a four bedroom unit that has a spacious gathering area and large wood burning fireplace. Executive 1 is one of 17 open year-round for snowmobilers, ice fishermen / women and other winter hobbies. Enjoy the sights and sounds of the Northwoods during any and all seasons.



Dockside (pictured above) is a 3 bedroom lake front unit that is popular during all seasons. All units have outdoor fire pits, wood provided free of charge. 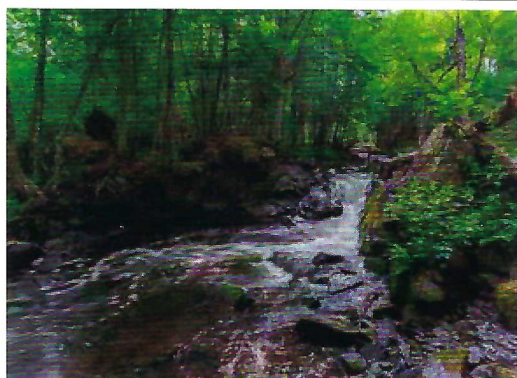
POINTS OF INTEREST

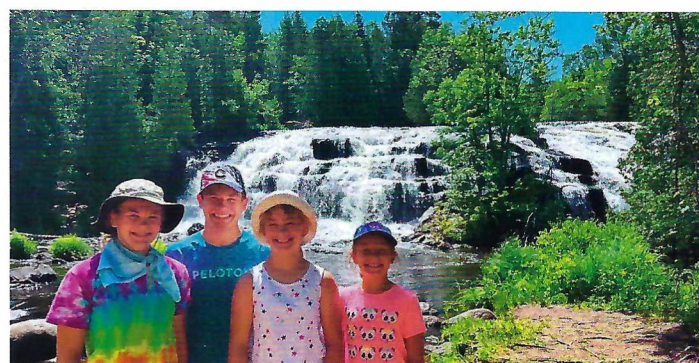
The Northwoods has an abundance of natural scenery for you to explore. Ask any staff member for their personal favorite Point of Interest.



Check out the Northern Lights, just one of many natural wonders that you can experience at Sunrise Lodge during your stay. Every season is beautiful in the Northwoods with so many things to do. September offers fantastic ruffed grouse

hunting and bow hunting for whitetail deer. October is the season for chasing trophy muskies and hunting black bear and (big foot). November marks the opener of the traditional gun deer hunting season in Wisconsin and Michigan.

Local communities hold numerous festivals and activities year 'round such as the World Championship Snowmobile Derby, 3-Bear-Sled Dog Races, Blizzard Blast, and Maple Syrup Fest in April. Scarecrow Fest, Cranberry Fest and musky fishing tournaments are popular in the fall while art & craft shows, waterski shows, flea markets and concerts are plentiful in the summer months.

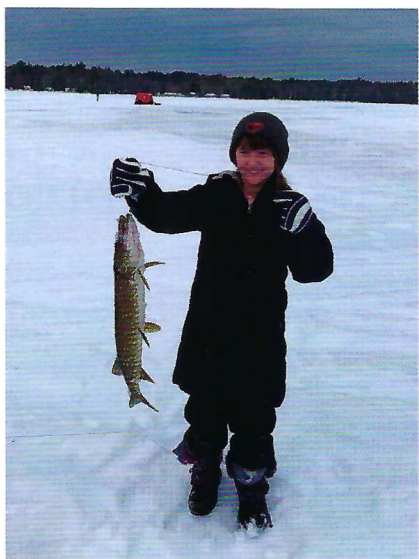
EXPERIENCE WINTER AT SUNRISE LODGE

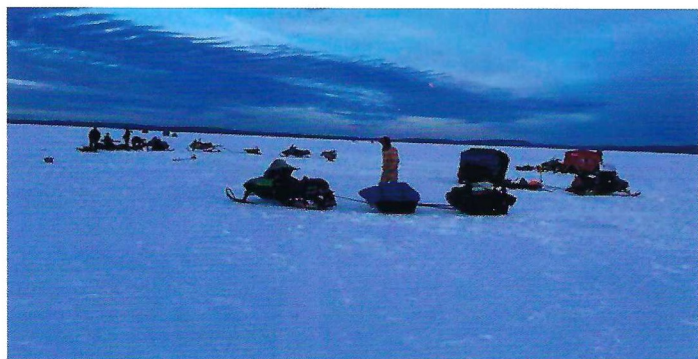
The heated garage has been popular for those snowmobilers and ice fishermen who have to do some repairs or thawing out of their equipment.

Walleye, northern, and largemouth bass season open May 4, 2024, while musky opener is June 1st. Smallmouth bass season opens June 15 – catch and release only before that. Panfishing (perch, bluegill, and crappie) provides great action and the season is always open.



A smile is worth a thousand words and shows that a great day on the water is way more fun than a day (or night) at work. Nothing beats a beautiful day on the water. Enjoy peace and tranquility, admire the natural beauty of the Northwoods, and watch the wildlife show unfold around you while you wet a line. Eagles often perch in the pine trees overlooking the handicap accessible Sunrise dock looking for an easy meal. A great photo opportunity.

May 4th brings the excitement of "Opening Day" for walleye, northern, and largemouth bass. Early spring is an excellent time to target post spawn walleyes and perch. Later in May and early June features excellent crappie and bluegill action. Lac Vieux Desert is the home of the world record tiger musky. If you don't know the area lakes, it is a good idea to hire a local guide. Phil or Erika will be happy to recommend a guide for you. The Sunrise Lodge rental fleet now consists of five pontoon boats and six 16' Ft deluxe fishing boats. Make sure to reserve yours Now!



This is why any day on the water beats a day at work. Reserve a pontoon or fishing boat from Sunrise Lodge and enjoy a great day on the water. Pontoons are great for fishing, nature viewing or cruising. Sunrise has 5 pontoon boats for rent by the ½ day, day, or week. Reserve one of the deluxe 16 foot fishing boats equipped with live well, trolling motor, and depth finder.



The trophy of a lifetime (or not?) could be at the end of your next cast. Perch, bluegills, crappies, bass, northern, walleye and muskies can be caught off the Sunrise docks or in Phil's "secret fishing hole." Sunrise Lodge promotes C.P.R. (Catch, Photo, Release) to ensure a great fishery for future generations.

FISHING FACTS

May 4, 2024 signals the opening of fishing season (Musky opens June 1st) on Lac Vieux Desert, a 4300 acre Michigan-Wisconsin boundary water noted for spring walleye, musky, northern, crappie, and perch. You need either a Michigan or Wisconsin fishing license, but not both on Lac Vieux Desert. Lac Vieux Desert is a trophy musky water so the size limit on musky is 50". You may want to consider hiring a local guide. Your guide will advise you on bait, equipment, and techniques so that you can maximize your enjoyment on the water. The rate for a half day of guide service is around \$250, which includes his or her boat and motor. We will be happy to recommend a guide for you.



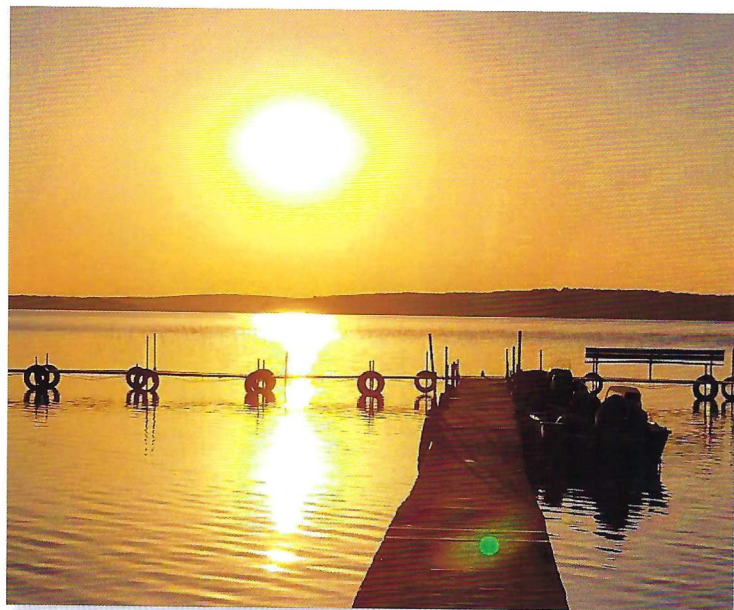

Trophy musky fishing peaks in September and October with Sunrise guests annually catching dozens of fish over 45 inches and some over 50 inches.
