
## **The Apostles Creed**

# 27th April 2025 2nd Sunday of Easter Divine Mercy Sunday



In today's Gospel, Jesus greets his disciples with the gift of peace and the gift of the Holy Spirit. Jesus also commissions his disciples to continue the work that he has begun. As Jesus was sent by God, so too does Jesus send his disciples.
