22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time



The 22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time brings us a strong message about humility. Jesus reminds us not to seek praise or high places. Instead, he shows us that real honour comes when we let go of pride. Those who lift themselves up will be brought down, but those who stay low will be raised up by God.
