### Indulged Acts for the Faithful Departed

1. A *plenary indulgence*, applicable only to the souls in purgatory, is granted to the faithful who, on any and each day from November 1 to 8, devoutly visit a cemetery and pray for the departed;

2. A *partial indulgence*, applicable only to the souls in purgatory, is granted to the faithful who devoutly visit a cemetery and at least mentally pray for the dead;

To gain a **Plenary Indulgence**

1. have the interior disposition of complete detachment from sin, even venial sin;

2. receive the **sacrament of confession** within 20 days of the act, one confession covers many indulgences;

3. receive the **Holy Communion** within 20 days of the indulgenced act, but one Communion per indulgence;

and recite **prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father** (one Our Father and one Hail Mary is suggested as a minimum, but any other additional prayers may be added).

**Daily Plenary Indulgence** (having fulfilled the above conditions)

1. Visit a cemetery
2. Pray for the dead

By this you can gain one plenary indulgence each day for a Holy Soul

**Today, Sunday 2nd November** is the Commemoration of all the Souls of the Faithful Departed. This is the day of remembering in prayer all the souls of those who have gone before us, but who may still be in need of the Church's prayers of petition for their deliverance from purgatory and entry into heaven. We are all encouraged to visit the cemetery and pray for the souls in Purgatory.

**November** is a special month when we remember our dead. The families and friends who have lost loved ones during the past 12 months have been invited to come to a special Mass to remember them. The Masses will be on **11th, 18th and 25th November** at 7.30pm.

**Prayer for Vocations:** On this Holy Souls' Day we remember the deceased priests who served the people of this diocese in the past. We pray for the priests who serve our parishes today, and for the men who will have the pastoral care of our people in the years to come, our current seminarians and those discerning their vocation at this time.
