


God of Joy

The third Sunday of Advent is traditionally called *Gaudete Sunday*. *Gaudete* is the Latin word meaning “rejoice.” This Sunday is so named because “Rejoice” is the first word in the entrance antiphon for today's Mass. Rejoice in the Lord always; again I say, rejoice! The Lord is near.”

In today's Gospel, John sends word to Jesus from prison, asking if Jesus is the Messiah for whom he has been waiting. Jesus responds by pointing to the miracles that he has worked and invites John and the other hearers to make their own determination. In his next

breath, however, Jesus praises John for his role in preparing the way for Jesus. Today, we are called to prepare our hearts during Advent through repentance as we prepare to encounter Christ at Christmas.

Bambino Sunday is celebrated today, where families bring their figures of the Baby Jesus from their homes to be blessed. This custom started by Pope St. John Paul II, helps to focus the family on the anticipation of Christmas and the coming of Jesus. You are invited to bring the figure of the baby Jesus from your home crib to Mass this weekend. The figures will be blessed at Mass. After the blessing, the figure taken home and wrapped. It's the first gift to be unwrapped by the youngest member of the family on Christmas morning and placed in the crib.

2025 Parish Draw: The final draw for this year is on **Saturday 20th December** after the Vigil Mass in the Community room. There will be a cup of tea for everyone and we will have 3 extra prizes of £100 for Christmas.

2026 Parish Draw: There is still time to buy a ticket (perhaps as a Christmas present) or promote them within your family and friends. Tickets cost of £120 cash or by standing order, £10 per month. **The 2025 standing orders** will expire at the end of this month; so if you want to continue to be in the Draw for next year, you will need to re-apply for a new ticket. You can do this by calling into the Sacristy after any week-end Mass or at the Parish Office.

Christmas Mass Bouquet Cards are available to purchase (£2.00 each) in the sacristy and at the back of the Church after week-end Masses. They are also available in the Parish Office, Monday - Friday 10am - 1pm. The recipients intentions will be remembered in a triduum of Masses which will be celebrated over the Christmas period.
