

FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR

The 16th Sunday in Ordinary Time, Year C, focuses on the

importance of balancing action and contemplation, and the need to prioritize listening to God's word. The gospel reading, Luke 10:38-42, presents the story of Martha and Mary, highlighting how Martha's focus on serving distracted her from actively listening to Jesus, while Mary chose the "better part" of sitting at his feet and listening. This Sunday encourages reflection on how to find balance between work and prayer, and how to cultivate a deeper relationship with God through attentive listening and contemplation.

The familiar story of Martha and Mary presents a classic conflict between action and contemplation. Martha is busy with the tasks of hospitality, while Mary sits at Jesus' feet, listening to his teaching. When Martha complains that Mary isn't helping, Jesus gently corrects her, saying that Mary has chosen the "better part" – the part that will not be taken away from her.

The Gospel doesn't suggest that serving is unimportant. Rather, it emphasizes the need to find a balance between active engagement in the world and quiet time for reflection and prayer. We need to be like Mary, making time to listen to God's word and nurture our relationship with Him.

Reflect on how you spend your time and make conscious choices to create space for prayer and reflection. This might involve setting aside specific times for prayer, attending Mass regularly, or simply taking a few moments each day to be still and listen to God.

HURRICANE PRAYER

God, All-powerful Father, Christ, our Savior, Spirit of Love, You reveal yourself in the depths of our being, drawing us to share in Your life and love. Be near to the people formed in Your image. Close to the world, Your love brings us to live. Save us from all harm. Draw us ever closer to You as we confidently seek Your protection from the destructive force of all storms which frighten us. Let every hurricane or natural threat of disaster serve only to blow us ever more securely into Your loving, merciful embrace. We ask this, Father, with the intercession of the Virgin Mother, Mary, Lady of all Nations, through your Son, Jesus Christ, and the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever. Amen.
