FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR

These are hard words: "Do you think that I have come to bring peace to the earth? No, I tell you, but rather division!" The

division Jesus speaks of is not an end in itself, but a result of the challenge his message brings. When the gospel takes root, it can disrupt the status quo. Those who embrace Christ's call may find themselves misunderstood or opposed by those closest to them. Even households may be divided, as Jesus boldly states: "from now on five in one household will be divided, three against two and two against three."

Dietrich Bonhoeffer, in his influential work "The Cost of Discipleship," writes that "when Christ calls a person, he bids them come and die." The gospel is not an invitation to an easy life, but to a costly allegiance to God's kingdom. Christianity, when truly lived, demands our whole selves—not just our Sunday mornings or our spare hours, but our deepest loyalties. This may mean standing apart from the crowd, risking misunderstanding, or even enduring rejection for the sake of Christ. There is a fire in discipleship—a burning away of the old, a forging of the new. The peace Jesus brings is not superficial or sentimental, but hard-won and world-changing.

Luke 12:49-53 challenges us to move beyond a comfortable, cultural Christianity into the blazing center of God's purpose. Jesus calls us to a faith that is real, refined, and resolute—a faith willing to endure the fire for the sake of new life. May we be people who welcome Christ's refining fire, who bear the cost of discipleship, and who become, by grace, living witnesses to the hope that endures beyond every division. Let us pray for the courage to be faithful, the humility to be transformed, and the wisdom to remember that, after the fire, God brings forth something new—pure, bright, and beautiful, for the sake of the world.

HURRICANE PRAYER

God, All-powerful Father, Christ, our Savior, Spirit of Love, You reveal yourself in the depths of our being, drawing us to share in Your life and love. Be near to the people formed in Your image. Close to the world, Your love brings us to liFe. Save us from all harm. Draw us ever closer to You as we confidently seek Your protection from the destructive force of all storms which frighten us. Let every hurricane or natural threat of disaster serve only to blow us ever more securely into Your loving, merciful embrace. We ask this, Father, with the intercession of the Virgin Mother, Mary, Lady of all Nations, through your Son, Jesus Christ, and the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever. Amen.
