

## FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR

## SCRIPTURE READINGS OF THE WEEK

Sunday, August 31: 22nd SUNDAY IN OT

What does it mean to practice humility? It is not self-abasement or false modesty, but a recognition of our place before God and others. Humility means we acknowledge that our worth is not measured by where we sit, who we know, or what we have accomplished. Our value comes from God's love, freely given.

In the world, the race for honor often leaves us weary, competitive, and dissatisfied. We measure ourselves against others, fearing that we will be overlooked. Yet Jesus teaches that those who seek recognition for themselves will be disappointed, while those who serve quietly, who give way to others, who choose the "lowest seat," will be raised up—not by their own efforts but by the grace of God.

Consider the cross, the ultimate sign of humility. Jesus did not seize power, but emptied himself, taking on the form of a servant, obedient even to death. The Father exalted him, giving him the name above every name (Philippians 2:5-11). Our calling is to follow Christ's example: to let go of pride and self-promotion, trusting that God sees and honors those who walk humbly.
