## FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR

The metaphor of the "narrow door" stands at the center of the passage. What does it mean? The narrow door is not a physical

threshold, but a symbol of the cost and commitment required to follow Jesus. It is not that God delights in making things difficult or excluding people. Rather, the narrowness speaks to the undivided heart, the single-minded devotion, the willingness to leave behind distractions and sins.

To "strive" is to struggle, to put forth effort, to contend with obstacles. Salvation is a free gift, but the journey of discipleship demands intentionality. It calls us to examine our lives, to repent, to reorder our loves. It is not enough to be merely acquainted with Jesus or to linger on the edges of faith. We are called to press in, to seek Him wholeheartedly.

Jesus warns that "many...will seek to enter and will not be able." This is a sobering word. It is not that the door is locked arbitrarily, but that some will delay, will presume, will imagine that mere proximity to the things of God is sufficient. The moment comes when the master of the house closes the door, and those outside find themselves knocking in vain.

The passage carries a sense of urgency. The door is open, but not forever. There is a time for seeking, for repentance, for response. Jesus calls us to seize the moment, to enter while we may. The tragedy of the story is not that the door is narrow, but that some wait too long, presuming they have time, failing to grasp the seriousness of the invitation.

The call to "strive to enter" is not a call to self-righteous striving, but to earnest seeking. It is a call to examine our hearts, to lay aside all that hinders, to pursue the life God offers. We are invited to enter into relationship with Christ, to participate in the joy of His kingdom.

#### **HURRICANE PRAYER**

God, All-powerful Father, Christ, our Savior, Spirit of Love, You reveal yourself in the depths of our being, drawing us to share in Your life and love. Be near to the people formed in Your image. Close to the world, Your love brings us to life. Save us from all harm. Draw us ever closer to You as we confidently seek Your protection from the destructive force of all storms which frighten us. Let every hurricane or natural threat of disaster serve only to blow us ever more securely into Your loving, merciful embrace. We ask this, Father, with the intercession of the Virgin Mother, Mary, Lady of all Nations, through your Son, Jesus Christ, and the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever. Amen.
