## FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR

To understand the magnitude of Jesus' statement, we must first

grasp the context in which it is spoken. In Luke 12, Jesus is teaching his disciples about vigilance and faithfulness in the face of the coming of God's kingdom. He uses parables to describe servants waiting for their master's return, emphasizing the importance of readiness, trust, and responsibility.

In verse 48, Jesus concludes the Parable of the Faithful and Unfaithful Servant. He contrasts those who know their master's will and act accordingly with those who neglect their responsibilities. The message is clear: awareness brings accountability. The more we know, the more we are expected to do.

Each of us has been given gifts—talents, resources, opportunities, knowledge, and relationships. Some have more, some have less, but all have something. Jesus' words are not merely about material wealth, but about every way in which we have been blessed.

To whom much is given, much is required. This is not a warning to the rich alone, nor a call to works-based righteousness. It is an invitation to faithful stewardship. If you have been granted love, extend it to others. If you possess wisdom, share it. If you have influence, use it to uplift. If you have material resources, let generosity become your song.

Let us not compare our gifts to those of others, nor measure our responsibilities against another's. Each servant receives according to their ability, and each is asked to respond with faithfulness.

### **HURRICANE PRAYER**

God, All-powerful Father, Christ, our Savior, Spirit of Love, You reveal yourself in the depths of our being, drawing us to share in Your life and love. Be near to the people formed in Your image. Close to the world, Your love brings us to live. Save us from all harm. Draw us ever closer to You as we confidently seek Your protection from the destructive force of all storms which frighten us. Let every hurricane or natural threat of disaster serve only to blow us ever more securely into Your loving, merciful embrace. We ask this, Father, with the intercession of the Virgin Mother, Mary, Lady of all Nations, through your Son, Jesus Christ, and the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever. Amen.
