

FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR

Persistent prayer does not mean mindless repetition

or relentless nagging. Instead, it is a testament to our faith and trust in God. It is the continual coming before our Heavenly Father, trusting in His timing, wisdom, and love, no matter how long it takes for our prayers to be answered.

Throughout Scripture, we find powerful examples of those who prayed persistently. One of the most compelling is the parable Jesus told in Luke 18:1-8 about the persistent widow. The widow came repeatedly to a judge who neither feared God nor cared about people. Yet, because of her persistence, the judge granted her justice. Jesus used this parable to teach us "that we should always pray and not give up."

Another example is found in the story of Hannah in 1 Samuel 1. Year after year, Hannah poured out her heart to God, grieving her barrenness. She did not cease praying, and in God's perfect timing, her prayer was answered and she bore a son, Samuel.

Some may wonder: If God is loving and all-knowing, why do we need to be persistent in our prayers? Persistence is not for God's benefit, but for ours. Through persistent prayer, God shapes our character, builds our faith, and draws us closer to Himself. It is in the waiting and the struggle that we learn patience, humility, dependence, and trust.

God, All-powerful Father, Christ, our Savior, Spirit of Love, You reveal yourself in the depths of our being, drawing us to share in Your life and love. Be near to the people formed in Your image. Close to the world, Your love brings us to liFe. Save us from all harm. Draw us ever closer to You as we confidently seek Your protection from the destructive force of all storms which frighten us. Let every hurricane or natural threat of disaster serve only to blow us ever more securely into Your loving, merciful embrace. We ask this, Father, with the intercession of the Virgin Mother, Mary, Lady of all Nations, through your Son, Jesus Christ, and the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever. Amen.
