<p>Gaudete Sunday invites us to pause amid Advent’s quiet longing and breathe in a deeper, brighter hope. Marked by rose-colored vestments and the call to <i>rejoice</i>, it reminds us that even while we wait for Christ’s coming, joy is already breaking into our lives. This joy is not naïve or escapist; it grows in the very places where we most need God’s healing—our uncertainties, anxieties, and unfulfilled desires.</p> <p>John the Baptist’s cry in the wilderness echoes through this Sunday, urging us to prepare our hearts not through fear, but through attentive expectation. We are called to notice signs of God’s nearness: small reconciliations, quiet acts of kindness, or moments when peace surprises us. Gaudete Sunday tells us that grace is at work even before our waiting ends.</p> <p>In the darker seasons of life, it can be difficult to rejoice. Yet this Sunday proclaims that joy is not the reward at the end of the journey; it is a companion along the way, offered by a God who draws near with gentleness. Simbang Gabi or Dawn Masses is a well-loved Filipino Catholic tradition of nine-day series of dawn masses leading up to Christmas. The mass is usually celebrated before sunrise. It is a spiritual preparation for Christmas, honoring the Blessed Virgin Mary and anticipating the birth of Jesus. Devotees traditionally believe that completing all nine masses brings special blessings.
