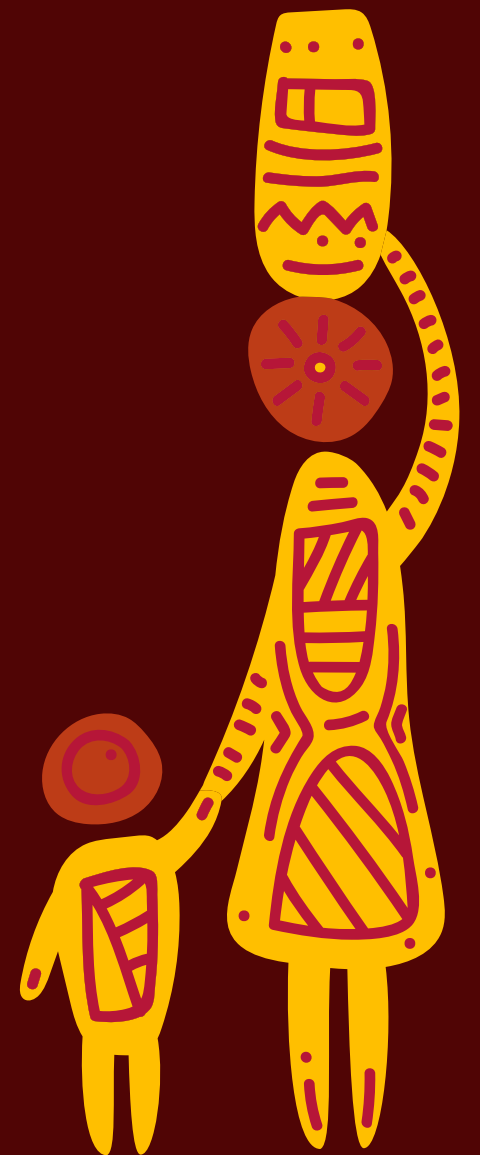
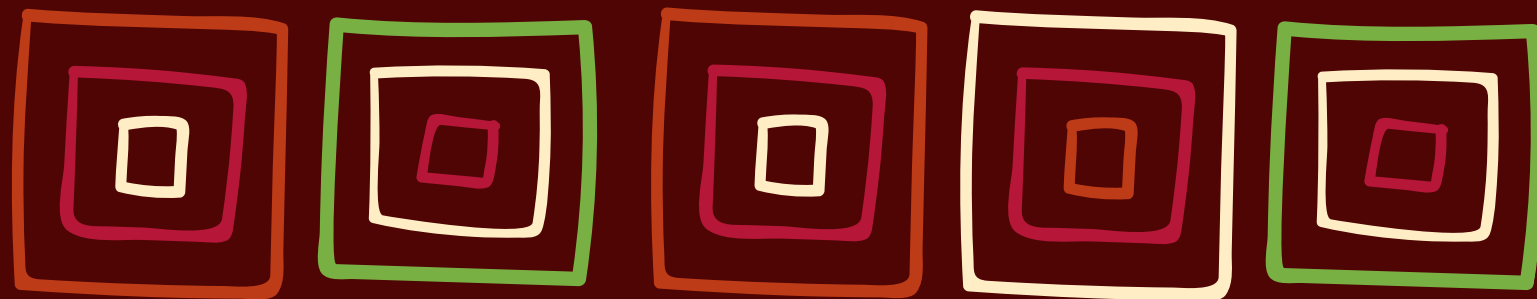


\$500,000 Donation Impact Summary

A \$500,000 donation powers deep, wide-reaching transformation—establishing sustainable food systems, generating household income, and creating tens of thousands of jobs across communities.





Families & People Helped

- 6,250 families receive 2 garden towers each
- The combination of two garden towers provides 31,250 people with consistent access to food and economic resilience



Food Security

- Each family grows vegetables for 3 - 5 meals per week
- Total meals produced: 18,750–31,250 nutritious meals every week



Income Generation

- The second tower provides income through surplus vegetable sales
- Each family earns \$12 - \$15 per month
- Community wide income impact: \$75,000–\$93,750



Job Creation

- 12,500 garden towers = 50,000 job opportunities (sewing, building, training)
