


June 2025 Median Estimated Property Value



















This chart shows the percentage of people in an area whose highest educational achievement is an associate degree, compared with other geographies.




Bachelor's Degree






Population of Children by Age Group in 34237






Households With Children in 34237






Occupational Categories in 34237






Presidential Voting Pattern in 34237






Average Commute Time










Average Monthly Temperature



Data Layers

Flood Zones



This map layer shows an area's flood zone designation as determined by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). A high-risk area has a 1 percent or greater annual chance of flooding and a 26 percent chance of flooding over the life of a 30-year mortgage. High-risk areas are red or orange. The coast areas, shown in purple, are also considered high risk. Green areas are low to moderate risk. A moderate-risk area is between risk limits of a 100-year and 500-year flood. White areas are undetermined, and all other areas are considered no or low risk.
