

OFFICIAL CONFERENCE PACKING LIST FOR SAN DIEGO

Clothing:

- Business attire (suits, blouses, dress shirts, dress pants, skirts, dresses)
- Comfortable shoes for walking (flats, loafers, or low-heeled shoes)
- Sandals or flip-flops for the pool or beach
- Socks or hosiery
- Belt
- Casual attire for after-conference activities (lightweight clothing for warmer temperatures)
- Sweater or light jacket for cooler indoor temperatures or evenings
- Sleepwear and undergarments

Accessories:

- Name badge or conference ID
- Lanyard or badge holder
- Professional briefcase or bag
- Wallet or purse
- Business cards
- Pens and notepad for taking notes
- Mobile phone and charger
- Laptop or tablet (if necessary)
- Power bank (in case of low battery)
- Headphones (for any audio/video presentations or webinars)
- Sunglasses

Toiletries and personal care items:

- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Shampoo, conditioner, and soap (hotel provides)
- Deodorant
- Hairbrush or comb
- Makeup and cosmetics (if applicable)

- Medications (if necessary)
- First aid kit (band-aids, pain relievers, etc.)
- Hand sanitizer
- Tissues or wet wipes
- Sunscreen

Documents and Miscellaneous:
