## **Amazon Influencer System**

## The Amazon Influencer program

is an amazing program that allows you to take advantage of a program they've created that can make you money by simply reviewing products you buy. It really is that simple, but there is obviously a set up process.



The influencer program was setup MAINLY for bloggers and social media personalities to be able to easily generate sales for products on Amazon. Think about it, it makes perfect sense right? Amazon wants to make more sales so they are "empowering" influencers and people with an audience.

Amazon allows influencers to create a "storefront" and they can drive people to their store which shows all of the products they like.

So let's give you the 30,000 foot overview. There is a program (The Amazon Influencer Program) that allows people to get paid for making simple video reviews of products that you buy or products that are sold on Amazon (yes, you can get paid for a review of a product that you didn't actually buy on Amazon). Simply upload a video to Amazon, wait till it gets approved (2 days), and anytime someone watches the video and then makes a "Qualifying purchase" (which Amazon isn't very clear on what that is... but let's assume it's a sales of that item), you get a commission.

There is a part of this program that almost no one is talking about that allows you to make money without having to be a big influencer and without having to send a SINGLE person to a store.

# **Influencer Storefront**



Store type #1 is the one I described above. You build a storefront and drive people to it, if someone buys you get a percentage of that sales based on the chart below.

This is important, ANY TIME someone watches one of your videos and then buys something from Amazon... you get a commission.

So the problem MOST people have here is that they don't have a large audience or following making it almost impossible to get.



Now, let's talk about "Store 2".



# Approved to the program.

It's said you should have at LEAST 1,000 followers... but I'll explain a cool way around this to get you in.



# Traffic to the products you review.


This is "affiliate marketing 101" here. If you review products but no one sees them... you won't make any money. But Amazon did something to help you here!

# On Amazon Placement



This is the secret to all of this working without you having to do any "work". In order to incentivize influencers to post reviews and build a presence on Amazon, Amazon created a category called "On Amazon Placement".

#### It looks like this.



As you can see, this is a product listing for a Sunrise simulating Alarm clock. On the right there are two videos from the company themselves listed in the top right under "Videos For This Product"... but then there is a video category labeled "Related Videos".

Queue the music...


Anytime someone watches that video and then buys this alarm clock... You guessed it... I get paid a commission.

That video listed under "Related Videos" is mine.

# How does someone find this video? I'll show you.




#### This is your typical Amazon listing page...



... but you'll notice under the primary picture there are a bunch of other pictures and even a "Videos" box.

#### When you click the "Videos" you get this page.



What do you know... listed under the "Related Videos", in the second spot, is MY VIDEO!

This particular product is \$900 and is in the "Home and Garden" category which means I get a whopping 4% of every sale that's made after someone watches my video in that list.

#### You may have some questions now like...

What happens if someone watches MY video, and then watches someone else's... who gets the commission?

#### OR

How much of the video does someone have to watch in order for it to count?

#### OR

What if someone watches my video, and then leaves.. but buys again in 30 days? These are all great questions... the answers to which are seemingly unknown honestly. It's not in their system and I can't seem to find solid answers anywhere.

#### Here's what I can tell you.

Those things don't really matter to me because this is so freaking easy to make money with it's only fair that SOMETHING about it is complicated and left to the unknown to stop the "overthinkers" from trying it.

All I know is that when I post, almost all of my videos get placed on the videos I review for.

## **How To Sign Up**

In order to get this moving, the first thing you need to do is create your account!



The only part of this that MAY hold you is your current "limited followers" which we've created a cool community to help you with. Amazon seems to show preference to people with 1,000+ followers so if you don't have that on Youtube, Instagram, Facebook or TikTok then you should get that before progressing forward.

#### This is not easy for everyone - which is why we created our Amazon Influencer Crew...

it's a group of people are committed to making this a REAL thriving income stream and we all work together to help each other. Since there are millions of products on Amazon we don't have to worry about competition or anything... so why not start a group that works together to share what's working!

Well, as part of that crew we actually all help each other get a bit of a following. The more we grow the crew, the more we can follow each others accounts, enabling more and more people to tap into this income stream.

Once you join the crew, we will be letting all of our team know that you've joined... and they'll follow you on the social media channel you choose!

## Ok... now, let's assume you have 1,000 people following you on some account... these are the next steps.

1

#### Sign up for an Amazon Influencer account

You can do this by visiting the <u>Amazon Influencer Program</u> registration page and filling out the form. Make sure you pay attention to the instructions given so that you provide all the necessary information.

2

#### **Create your channel**

Once your profile is set up, it's time to create your channel. This is where all of your video reviews will be located for potential customers to view. Pick a name that best reflects your brand or personality and stick with it throughout the process. I used my family name to make it seem LESS like a "review" channel... and more relatable.

#### **Customize Your Channel**

Customize your channel with the profile picture and the "header" picture. If you don't know what to put... just use Canva and make something cool. Don't go super cheesy and try to use pictures of YOU because that's what will attract people to your other videos.

PS. If you don't have 1,000 followers and don't want to be a part of a SUPER affordable and cool crew that will absolutely pay for itself 100x over... you CAN try submitting your application with your current social media and see if Amazon approves it. I HAVE heard of some people getting approved without following at all.




Once you sign up you'll be approved for an "Associates Account" which is the account you need to actually track your commissions.

They do ask that you fill out tax forms so obviously you'll want to do that.

The one thing that is SUPER IMPORTANT TO REMEMBER is that you have two stores when you sign up as an Influencer. You have "On Amazon" and your storefront.

In order to track the two you will need to switch between "stores" like the images below showcase:

That is a picture of your associates account when you login, and in the top right you can see "onamz" which is my "On Amazon" placement earnings.




# MAJOR INFO

It can take up to **TWO FULL MONTHS** 

to get approved
for "on Amazon

It took me almost 2 months exactly to get approved. There is no process you have to submit, or anyone you can talk to. You literally have ONE job...




In order to get that lock removed you HAVE TO HAVE 3 videos uploaded. Amazon will look at these are your "test" reviews and likely approve or deny you based on this.

Again, it took me 2 months and I made ZERO during this time because I didn't promote it any other way. DO NOT get discouraged, this is a process and it's worth continuing to upload. If anything, it'll make Amazon like you more if you are uploaded without getting on site placement.

Remember, this program is supposed to be specifically for big influencers, and big influencers would likely review stuff no matter if they had on site placement or not.

All that said, you could get approved in a matter of days... but don't be shocked if you are seeing nothing for weeks or even months.

# The Perfect Review Outline



There isn't really much you HAVE TO DO here. The fact that the user is already on the product page and is likely considering the product before watching your review means that you don't need high quality video, you don't need to include your face if you don't want to, and the audio quality can be "rough" since these are all cell phone style videos... there really isn't a whole lot you have to do to "increase conversions", but I'm a marketing nerd so I'm going to share what I do that I THINK helps.

I've done a TON of research and made multiple 5 figures in the "review" space over the years. I started writing reviews for cell phone cases back in the day and even had a site ranked #5 for the iPhone 5 release (which made me like \$5,000/ day in ad revenue until I screwed that up...)

There is a format to a good review, a format that will help your buyer feel like your review was more complete and leave less questions in their mind... THEREFORE... this should lead to more sales for you.

See, if we fulfill the buyers need for a holistic review, they are likely NOT to watch other reviews before buying... so we should do our best to make "good reviews".

## Here's the format that I've used over the past 12 years.

Start by introducing the product and providing some background information on it. Literally 5-8 seconds. Make sure you start your camera on the object because, I've found, Amazon takes the thumbnail from the first few seconds of the video and the thumbnail is a bit part of the success of the

Discuss the pros and cons of the product.

Be honest and objective, and consider both the good and bad aspects of the product. If you want someone to trust you, you're going to need to disclose negatives as well as positives. I like to think of three things to talk about in each video before I shoot it. Something cool, my least favorite thing about the product, my favorite thing about the product.

Include any personal experiences or anecdotes that relate to the product. This can help make the review more relatable and engaging. This is easy if you actually use the thing you are reviewing because you have real experience of what you've done with it. If you can think of something that stands out as a specific use case, definitely tell that. Every product is different so this may not be super important if you're reviewing toothpaste or something. But even deodorant could have a cool story about someone telling you how good you smelled or something.

Offer any tips or recommendations for using the product. Some little "after 3 months I always..." or "I wish I had known this sooner" type share.

Conclude the review by summarizing your overall thoughts on the product and whether or not you would recommend it to others. So now you get to give your "Virtual stars" or some sort of overall rating on how you like it and if you would recommend it. TYPICALLY you are going to always recommend a product, but you could always end with a "if you are an advanced chef you may not like this cutting board because it's a little small, but if you need something to fit a small space this is perfect". See there I make it SPECIFIC to someone in particular vs. giving an "everyone should buy this" review.

# That's it. You don't have to get too in depth about MOST products.

If you are reviewing the floor mat in your bathroom... this shouldn't be more than a 2 minute video.

In fact, we have to assume that Amazon uses similar metrics as Youtube when deciding what videos to show in the Related Videos section... so watch time is important. Having a 10 minute video reviewing your favorite white tee shirt is NOT a good thing if we are right about watch time being important.

I have MANY reviews under a minute because most things don't need a lot of time to showcase what something does. You'll be reviewing EVERYTHING YOU OWN (that is sold on Amazon) which means pillows, towels, toothbrushes, deodorant... you don't need to be too in depth for this to work.

#### **Video MUST HAVES**

I wanted to list a few notes about making the review videos that I've found helpful or that I know is helping on some videos.

1

# I try to review products that DO NOT have 5+ videos already listed in the "Related Videos" section.

Think about it like trying to rank on Google. The more competition, the harder it'll be for us to beat the previously listed videos. So let's try to look for products that don't have Related Videos if we can. (Does that mean you shouldn't review products that have Related Videos, absolutely not, review EVERYTHING)

2

#### Start your video with the product in focus.

Amazon likes to automatically pull a thumbnail (you are allowed to edit this, but why bother) from the first few seconds of the video so having the product in full focus makes this showcase the product better.

3

#### A good review structure (see earlier).


If you don't have a solid review foundation you should try watching other peoples reviews (Mostly on Youtube) and try to create an outline for how they review. What do they talk about, when do they talk about it, etc.

# How to Upload Your Video

1. You will need to go to your Storefront url...

It would look like this





#### 2. Next, click "Create Content" and you'll see three options.

Post (video & photo)


Idea List

Livestream

We're going to be focused on "Post" here but the Idea List and Livestream is a really lucrative tool as you start to grow.

#### 3. Next step, you click "Post"

And you'll have a spot to upload your video, you'll be able to tag the actual product you're reviewing, and then you'll also be able to give that video a title.

4. As you can see I tagged these UGG slippers by clicking the little "Checkbox" in the top right of the product I'm reviewing.

#### 5. The next, and VERY important piece of this entire process, is the TITLE!



#### This is a review for a "Yoto player" my kids love.

The video is 1:43 which is all it really needed... the thumbnail is of the product in it's actual place, and the title is "Honest review of Yoto audio player for kids".

Simple right? Notice I am **ranked "first"** and I'm the only one that mentions that what I'm doing is a review. People love reviews.




The other videos on this page are just saying that they love them and they are cool. In fact, these reviews are both from the same person and are less than :30 long. Makes me think they aren't that helpful.

Another factor that will help you get more views, and therefore more sales, is how helpful your videos are. Which is why you shouldn't just shoot a :20 second video that says you love something. That's boring and not helpful to someone looking to buy that thing.

Use the review strategy I give you in this document.

#### But also - check out this picture.



That means someone thought that video was helpful... therefore showing Amazon that my review was good.

That's why it's SUPER important to give a real review, be honest, mention any potential negatives, be real.

If you also look at the image I shared above, you'll see on the right the "playlist" which shows some of my other reviews. Notice how long they are?

All but 2 are less than 3 minutes. The 2 that are longer are more complicated products. One is a microphone and I made that review longer for several reasons:

- There are a lot of reviews for that product, so I need my review to be thorough and helpful
- Microphones are obviously ALL about sound so I had to showcase the sound quality so I actually recorded the audio for that video on my iPhone and on the mic itself allowing me to show both audios so they can see the way it sounds.
- People who buy microphones have specific questions about how a microphone compares to other microphones... so I wanted to make sure I touched on those.

#### Let's Get Started!

Now that you've seen EXACTLY what we do, and how we do it, there would potentially be a few things that could hold you back from doing this on your own.

You may not have enough followers to qualify for the Influencer Program as Amazon requires at LEAST 1,000 (as stated on their website) but we've found that they like to see more in the range of 3,000+.

You may not want to start a new venture without any ability to get support. There are obvious hiccups when making this work, so having someone around to help as you get stuck is a BIG advantage.

You may not know exactly how to get approved for the "On Site Placement" part of this. Once you apply to be an influencer, if you get approved, You need to upload videos in a VERY specific format to ensure that you get listed for on site placement. This is where the real "passive" income part is actually built.

You want CLEAR step-by-step advice and training to ensure that you follow the process exactly as it's meant to be, instead of being on your own trying to "figure it out".


