

Canadian Network of Evangelists Membership Agreement

The Canadian Network of Evangelists (CNE) exists to catalyze the work of evangelism in Canada by confirming the call of and providing community, coaching, and collaboration opportunities for Canadian evangelists. Our aim is to cultivate a network marked by mutual-sharpening, prayer, encouragement, theological reflection, and shared resources.

In becoming a member of CNE, you agree to:

1. Participate regularly in the life of the CNE.

We ask you to take part in opportunities to gather with other CNE members whether online or in-person. This could take the form of prayer calls, training webinars, coaching opportunities, Advance Summits, or regional CNE gatherings.

2. Provide information about your ministry activity and outcomes upon request.

We want to encourage you, pray for you, and lend assistance if we have the capability. Your regular communication with us will help to achieve this.

3. Commit to a spirit of mutual-sharpening and multiplication.

“And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable people who will also be qualified to teach others” (2 Timothy 2:20).

4. Abide by the CNE code of conduct.

CNE members are expected to uphold the highest standards of ethical, professional behavior, striving to live above reproach in the sight of God and man.

Members should recognize that the chief function of their ministry at all times is to serve God. As ambassadors for Jesus Christ, members should accept it as a personal duty to conduct themselves with honour, integrity, humility, and Christ-like love.

CNE members are expected to obey Canadian laws and/or the laws of the respective countries in which they serve. Members should treat all persons with respect and consideration regardless of race, religion, gender, maternity, marital or family status, disability, age, or national origin.

CNE reserves the right to terminate a member's CNE membership if it believes these standards are not being followed.

Indemnification Agreement

CNE members agree to indemnify, and hold harmless the Canadian Network of Evangelists and Message Canada and its officers, directors, employees, and agents (the “Indemnified Parties”) against any and all liability, loss, damage, or expenses that any Indemnified Party incurs on account of any claim, lawsuit, or other judicial dispute arising on account of any action (or alleged action) by the CNE member or any of its owners, directors, officers, employees, or agents.

CNE members using any Message Canada brand will include an express disclaimer of any warranties with respect to the services or products provided by the CNE member and an express agreement by any user not to sue CNE on account of any alleged breach of contract, tort, or other claim by the user against Message Canada and CNE.
