Salt Lake County Parks and Recreation: "My county rec pass" is required for each child. Please bring on the first day of camp.

Loveland Aquarium Art Program:

Children with a membership will partake of the special programming during the summer. Children will learn the science, ecosystem, protecting our planet. This is an addition to regular programming and is included in the tuition. We just

require a membership to the aquarium. Please provide the card on the first day of camp.

What to Bring to Camp:

- Clothing: Comfortable, weather-appropriate clothing with closed-toe shoes (required daily). No long sleeves on hot days.
- Lunch & Snacks: Pack a nutritious lunch and snacks daily. (We are NOT a nut-free camp.)
- Sun Protection: Apply sunscreen before camp and pack labeled sunscreen and a hat in your child's backpack.
 - Water Bottle: A labeled reusable water bottle is required every day.
- **Book:** We emphasize **reading time**—please send a chapter book for older readers.
- Water Shoes: Required on hot days when we play with water. No flipflops or Crocs—shoes must fasten securely.
 - Plastic Bag: For wet items on swim and hike days.
 - Emergency Kit: In a labeled Ziplock bag, please pack:
 - Shorts, underwear, socks, short-sleeve t-shirt
 - A **note card** with parent names & emergency phone numbers
 - Drop off the kit at the studio on the first day of camp.

Zero Tolerance for Bullying & Behavior Expectations

We maintain a zero-tolerance policy for bullying, aggression, and inappropriate language. Any camper who engages in physical or verbal aggression toward another camper, our team, or volunteers will be removed from camp immediately. If your child has had behavioral challenges at school or other camps, please inform us in advance. We reserve the right to dismiss any child from camp without a refund.

Safety, Weather & Animal Sightings

The safety of our campers is our top priority. In the event of weather changes, safety concerns, or wildlife sightings, we may **adjust planned activities or field trips.** We appreciate your patience and cooperation as we navigate outdoor experiences with children.

Medications & Allergies

- We do NOT administer medications.
- We are NOT a nut-free camp.
- Please inform us of any allergies upon registration.

Daily Hygiene & Personal Belongings

• Hygiene: Campers should arrive with brushed hair, clean clothes, and

proper attire for the day's activities.

- Sunscreen: Parents must apply sunscreen before camp. We will assist children as needed. If your child uses separate face and body sunscreen, label both clearly. Test new products before camp.
- Personal Belongings: Label EVERYTHING with your child's first and last name. (Sharpie may wash off water bottles, so use a durable label.)
