

**Town of Taylor Minutes of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen**  
**Regular Monthly Meeting on January 3, 2023**

1. CALL TO ORDER.

The meeting of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Taylor, Mississippi, was called to order by Mayor Hardy at 7:00 pm on Tuesday, the third day of January, 2023, with the following officers and members present, constituting a legal quorum to-wit:

2. ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA.

Mayor Hardy presented the Agenda and asked for an amended agenda to be accepted, so that a discussion of the sidewalks could be done as old business. It was moved by Alderman Taylor, seconded by Alderman Hewlett to adopt the amended agenda for the meeting. All the Aldermen present voting aye, Mayor Hardy declared the motion carried.

3. APPROVE PRIOR MEETING MINUTES.

It was moved by Alderman Taylor, seconded by Alderman Roberts to approve the minutes for the December 6, 2022 regular meeting. All the Aldermen present voting aye, Mayor Hardy declared the motion carried.

4. TOWN CLERK'S REPORT.

Clerk Conrad stated that we had issued 2 permits for Plein Air, 2 electrical permits and one gas permit during the month of December.

5. OLD BUSINESS

Mayor Hardy stated that she had received three quotes on replacing the sidewalks in Taylor. Mayor Hardy stated that the first estimate was done by Mustard Seed for \$55,200. Mayor Hardy then stated that the second estimate was done by Southern Hills for \$118,000. Mayor Hardy then stated that her third quote came in from someone that she personally has used and the quote was done by Alberto Rodrigues for \$28,832. Mayor Hardy said that the quotes included the removal of the old sidewalks. Mayor Hardy stated that she had spoken with Supervisor David Rikard who stated that the county would come and take the old concrete. Mayor Hardy stated that she had spoken with Mr. Rodrigues and that the sidewalk in front of Taylor United Methodist Church would not need to be replaced, as it is new, but that the replaced sidewalks should match the current one. Mr. Rodriguez agreed that this would be matched. After discussion, it was determined that Mayor Hardy would investigate putting a foot bridge up in the area north of Taylor United Methodist Church. Mayor Hardy also stated that she would check with the Department of Transportation to make sure that the clearing of the ditches would not harm the new sidewalks. It was moved by Alderman Taylor to approve the bid from

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Mr. Rodriguez, seconded by Alderman Hewlett. With all the Aldermen present voting aye, Mayor Hardy declared the motion carried.

6. NEW BUSINESS

Mr. Worth Duperior presented to the Alderman the possibility of changing the previous basketball court into a pickleball court. Mr. Duperior stated that he would like to do the court in stages, with the first stage to purchase a net. Mr. Duperior stated that he would like to see the area pressure washed and to ask Mr. Rodrigues if he could repair any cracks in the court when he repairs the sidewalks. There was a discussion then about expanding to two more courts, if we find that the pickleball court is used. It was moved by Alderman Taylor that we go ahead and pursue using Mr. Worth to get the pickleball court into stage 1, seconded by Alderman Edwards. With all the Aldermen present voting aye, Mayor Hardy declared the motion carried.




8. PUBLIC COMMENT - None.
