

Town of Taylor Minutes of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen
Regular Monthly Meeting on November 1, 2022

1. **CALL TO ORDER.**

The meeting of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Taylor, Mississippi, was called to order by Mayor Hardy at 7:00 pm on Tuesday, the first day of November, 2022, with the following officers and members present, constituting a legal quorum to-wit:

2. **ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA.**

It was moved by Alderman Edwards, seconded by Alderman Willingham to adopt the agenda for the meeting. All the Aldermen present voting aye, Mayor Hardy declared the motion carried.

3. **APPROVE PRIOR MEETING MINUTES.**

It was moved by Alderman Willingham, seconded by Alderman Edwards to approve the minutes for the September 6, 2022 regular meeting. All the Aldermen present voting aye, Mayor Hardy declared the motion carried.

4. **APPROVE CURRENT CLAIMS DOCKET.**

Mayor Hardy presented the current Claims Docket. It was moved by Alderman Roberts, seconded by Alderman Hewlett that the current Claims Docket be paid. All the Aldermen present voting aye, Mayor Hardy declared the motion carried.

5. **TOWN CLERK'S REPORT.**

Clerk Conrad stated that she had submitted two reports of the Planning Commission meetings to each of the Aldermen (attached) and reported that no permits had been issued during the month of October and there was no road report given.

6. **PUBLIC HEARING**

Mayor Hardy then opened the floor for the Public Hearing and asked Planning Consultant Judy Daniel to give the presentation of her report to each of the Aldermen and Citizens in attendance (attached). Ms. Daniel stated that this report showed the corrections, definitions and modifications to the Planning and Development Code. Ms. Daniel stated that the Aldermen had been informed of the changes and that the report had been presented to the Planning Commission at a called meeting and Public Hearing on October 11, 2022. Ms. Daniel stated each of the changes that were being made and stated that the Planning Commission had recommended their approval to the Board of Aldermen. 
9. MAYOR'S REPORT.


10. PUBLIC COMMENT - None.
