There are 9049 low-income students receiving free meals in the district. Many of these students receive support from our Washington County School District Foundation Counselor Closet, which provides essentials like shampoo and toothpaste.

Each day, representatives from at least one of our 50 schools visit the Foundation Counselor Closet at the district to replenish their school's supplies.

This vital resource supports students by providing essential items, ensuring their well-being and focus on education.

Relying on community donations, the Counselor Closet makes a tangible difference in students' lives, creating a nurturing educational environment.

More than a resource, the Counselor Closet symbolizes compassion. It's about neighbors helping neighbors, and the belief that every student deserves support. Our goal is to ensure that every student has the fundamental necessities to excel academically, while also showing them that they are valued and cared for.

We are excited the district will be opening Teen Resources Centers in five local high schools this fall, providing a safe space for students to shower, do laundry, and access the food pantry.
