Bible Study Guide for Families

Theme: Building Our Lives on God, Not Ourselves

Main Passage: Genesis 11:1-9

Memory Verse: Proverbs 18:10 – "The name of the Lord is a strong tower; the righteous run

into it and are safe."

Opening Discussion:

Ask Your Kids:

1. Have you ever tried to build something really big with blocks or Legos? What happened when it got too high?

- 2. Have you ever felt proud of something you made or did?
- 3. What do you think happens when people try to do things without listening to God?

Read Genesis 11:1-9 Together

- (For younger kids: Read from a children's Bible or summarize in simple terms.)
- Ask: Why did the people want to build the tower? (They wanted to be famous and powerful.)
- Ask: What did God do when He saw their pride? (He confused their language and scattered them.)

Key Lessons

1. Pride Makes Us Want to Be in Charge

- The people wanted to make their own name great instead of following God.
- Ask: Why is it better to listen to God than to try and be in charge all the time?
- o Bible Connection: Proverbs 3:5-6 Trust in the Lord, not in our own plans.

2. God Wants Us to Trust Him, Not Ourselves

- The people thought they could reach heaven **on their own**.
- Ask: Can we get to heaven by being good or working hard? Or do we need Jesus?
- o Bible Connection: John 14:6 Jesus is the only way to God.

3. God's Plan is Always Better

- Even when people failed, God had a plan (later through Abraham and Jesus).
- Ask: How can we trust God when we don't understand what's happening?
- Bible Connection: Romans 8:28 God works all things for good.

Family Activity: "Tower Challenge"

- **Supplies:** Blocks, Legos, or household items.
- Challenge: Work together to build the tallest tower you can.
- Twist: Halfway through, someone has to give different instructions in a made-up language to confuse the builders.
- **Discussion**: How did it feel when you couldn't understand each other? Why does working together with God's guidance work better?

Prayer Time

- Thank God that He is in control and we don't have to build our own way to Him.
- Ask God to help us trust Him more instead of being prideful.
