Bible Study for Adults

Main Idea: Abraham's journey teaches us about stepping out in faith, trusting God's promises, and surrendering everything to Him.

Opening Prayer:

Ask God to deepen your trust in Him and help you take bold steps of faith.

1 Follow Me and Multiply (Genesis 12:1-3)

- Read: Genesis 12:1-3
 - What did God ask Abraham to leave behind?
 - How is Abraham's journey similar to our spiritual journey today?

Q Going Deeper:

Read Matthew 28:19-20 – How does Abraham's call connect to the Great Commission?

Reflection Challenge: Identify an area where God is calling you to step out in faith. **What's stopping you?**

2 Trust Me and Multiply (Genesis 15:1-10)

- Read: Genesis 15:1-6
 - Why did Abraham struggle with doubt?
 - How did God reassure him?

Q Going Deeper:

Read Romans 4:18-21 – How does Abraham's faith serve as a model for us today?

Reflection Challenge: Write down a promise of God you are trusting Him for. Pray over it daily this week.

3 Prioritize Me and Multiply (Genesis 13:1-17)

- Read: Genesis 13:8-13
 - Why did Lot's choice seem wise but lead to trouble?
 - How does this passage challenge us to seek God's kingdom first?

Q Going Deeper:

Read Luke 12:15 – What does Jesus warn us about when making decisions?

Reflection Challenge: This week, intentionally choose God's kingdom over personal comfort in one decision.

4 Surrender to Me and Multiply (Genesis 22:1-18)

- Read: Genesis 22:1-14
 - Why did God test Abraham by asking for Isaac?
 - How does this foreshadow Christ's sacrifice?

Q Going Deeper:

Read **James 1:2-3** – How do trials test and refine our faith?

Reflection Challenge: Identify one area of your life that you need to fully **surrender to God** and pray over it this week.

Closing Reflection & Challenge

Faith Steps for Adults:

- Follow God's call without needing all the answers.
- Trust His promises, even when they seem delayed.
- Prioritize His kingdom over temporary gain.
- Surrender everything to Him.

Closing Prayer:

- Ask God for the courage to step out in faith.
- Pray for trust in His promises, even in waiting.
- Fully surrender all areas of your life to Him.
