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GAMENOTES - QUICK REFERENCE

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LAST TIME OUT

Mizzou won both of its two midweek games this past week, taking victories over Southern Illinois-Edwardsville (14-6 on Tuesday) and Illinois (7-4 on Wednesday). The Tigers got home runs from junior Jonah Schmidt and redshirt freshman Andreas Plackis on Tuesday in the win over SIUE. Plackis' home run was the first of his career. He drove in five runs on the night. Junior Jeff Scardino turned in seven innings pitched, allowing three runs on seven hits. He struck out three and walked none. Wednesday's victory over Illinois came at Busch Stadium in St. Louis. Senior Aaron Senne had three hits in the game and the Missouri bullpen did not allow a run and gave up only two hits in 7.2 innnigs pitched.

MIZZOU-OKLAHOMA SERIES HISTORY

Oklahoma holds a 145-104-1 lead in the all-time series between Mizzou and OU. Last season, Oklahoma won the three-game series played in Columbia, taking the first two games of the series by scores of 2-1 and 7-4, before the Tigers claimed a 5-4 win in the finale. *[See page 6 for more on last year's series]* The Sooners and Tigers also met at last year's Big 12 Championships, with Missouri taking a 5-4 win in that meeting. The last time the two teams met in Norman, the Tigers took the series winning the first two games of the weekend before dropping game three.

SENNE CARRIES CAREER-LONG HIT STREAK INTO OKLAHOMA SERIES

Aaron Senne has had three hits in each of the last three games and carries a career-best 13-game hitting streak into the series with Oklahoma. During the streak, Senne is hitting .569 (29-for-51), with eight doubles, three home runs and 18 RBI. The streak began when he went 2-for 3 in game two of a doubleheader with North Dakota on March 19. He had two hits in each of the first three games of the streak and has had eight multi-hit games. That includes a four-hit game in the series finale with Texas A&M and a 5-for-5 night against Purdue on March 30.

SENNE CLIMBING SEVERAL LISTS IN MU RECORD BOOK

Aaron Senne had back-to-back two-double games on March 28-30 to set a new record for career doubles at Missouri. After doubling in consecutive at-bats against Texas A&M on March 28 to move into a tie for first with Ryan Fry (1995-98) on Mizzou's career doubles, Senne went 5-for-5 with a home run and two doubles against Purdue on March 30 to break the record. He now has 60 doubles, putting him atop that list. Senne has 13 doubles on the year, which ranks second in the Big 12. His .450 average leads the conference. He leads the team with eight home runs on the year and has 34 home runs for his career, which puts him eighth all-time at Missouri. He is one away from moving into a tie with Ryan Stegall (1999-2001) and Dave Silvestri (1986-88) for sixth place. Senne is fourth in school history with 184 RBI. He is also fourth with 256 career hits, which is just 18 behind the career record holder Jayce Tingler (2000-03). Senne returned to Mizzou this season for his senior year, passing up a chance to join his hometown Minnesota Twins organization. A native of Rochester, Minn., he was drafted by Minnesota in last June's Major League Baseball Draft, but chose to return to Missouri. Senne hit his first home run of the season and drove in four against Washington on Feb. 20. At the Auburn Classic, Senne hit three home runs in a span of two games, finishing 3-for-5 with four RBI in the game. The ne

**MU IS ONLY TEAM WITH THREE-STRAIGHT 16-BIG 12 CONFERENCE WIN SEASONS**

Missouri is the only team in the Big 12 Conference that has won at least 16 conference games in each of the last three seasons. MU was 19-8 in 2007, then went 16-11 in both 2008 and 2009. The Tigers Big 12 record over the last three years is 51-30, which is second best in the Big 12 behind only Texas (53-27-1).

OPEL RECORDS MU'S FIRST THREE DOUBLE GAME SINCE 2002

Freshman Dane Opel was 3-for-4 in the final game of the three-game series with Baylor last weekend, with all three hits being doubles. He is the first Tiger to record a three-double game since Brad Flanders did it against Louisiana-Monroe in 2002. In his last six games, Opel is hitting .500 with four doubles, two home runs and 10 RBI. He had multiple hits in five-straight games from March 28-April 4, including three hits against Purdue on March 30, when he drove in four runs. In Big 12 games, Opel has a .529 average to lead the team. He went 4-for-5 in his debut as a Tiger on Feb. 20 against Washington and had a hit in each of the first three games in which he has played.

NICHOLAS ADAPTS TO MIZZOU

Junior Brett Nicholas takes a four-game hitting streak into the weekend series at OU and had an eight-game hitting from March 7-19, hitting .522 during the streak with three home runs and 12 RBI. He has recorded a hit in 19 of the 27 games in which he's had an at-bat this year and he has 13 multi-hit games, including the last five. Nicholas has had at least two hits in eight of the last nine games, hitting .415 (17-for-41), with 13 RBI over that stretch. On the year, Nicholas is hitting .363 with five home runs and a team-leading 34 RBI. Earlier in the year, he hit .444 with a slugging percentage of 1.444 in the three games against North Dakota. He had a home run in the series opener, then hit two homers in the first game of a Friday doubleheader. Nicholas hit .625 (5-for-8) in the Xavier series (March 12-14). He opened the series by going 3-for-4 with a double and an RBI in Friday's extra-inning victory, then drove in two runs on Saturday, finishing 1-for-2 with a single and a walk. On Sunday he was 1-for-2 and drew two walks.

28 GAMES, 28 LINEUPS

Head Coach Tim Jamieson has utilized a different lineup for all 28 games this season. Five different Tigers have been in the leadoff spot and four have hit cleanup. The spot in the lineup with the least amount of change is third spot where only two players (Aaron Senne 19 times, Brett Nicholas nine times) have been slotted. The seventh spot has seen the most changes, as 10 different Tigers have hit in the seven hole.

MCCORMICK SCOOPS UP VICTORIES

Junior Phil McCormick has picked up victories in each of his last two appearances and is 4-0 on the season. In his four wins, McCormick has pitched a total of just 3.1 innings. He has not allowed a run in any of those games. His first victory came on Feb. 21 against New Mexico State. McCormick faced just one batter in that game, forcing a double play to end the top of the 10th inning. The Tigers then scored the game-winning run in the bottom half of that inning to give McCormick the win. His second win came on March 13 against Xavier, when he faced three batters and got two outs in the top of the eighth before the Tigers broke the tie with a pair of runs in their half of the eighth inning. Last Sunday, McCormick faced just two batters and got the final out of the top of the seventh inning. Missouri then scored three runs in the bottom of the seventh to take a lead and go onto victory. On Wednesday, McCormick was the first MU reliever out of the bullpen and pitched 1.2 innings of scoreless baseball. Mizzou took the lead in the third inning while McCormick was still the pitcher of record. He leads the team with 18 appearances on the season and is second on the squad with a 2.31 ERA.

LIBERTO LEADS MIZZOU AT THE PLATE

Michael Liberto is one of just two seniors on the 2010 squad and heads into the weekend with a .381 average. Liberto had a nine-game game hitting streak from March 14-23, hitting .412 with a double, a triple and seven RBI during the streak. He has had at least one hit in all but five games in which he has had an at-bat this season and has had multiple hits in 13 of the 27 games he played in this season. Liberto opened up the year by hitting .692 at the Collegiate Cactus Classic in Tucson. He was 9-for-13 in the three games with a double, a triple and three RBI. Liberto matched his career best with four hits in a 4-for-5 performance against Gonzaga in the season opener, with a triple and two RBI.

TEPESCH LOOKS TO LEAD TIGER PITCHING STAFF

Nick Tepesch won six games last year, striking out 84 batters in 114.1 innings pitched. He picked up a win against Auburn on Feb. 27, his eighth career victory. He struck out five in 6.1 innings pitched against TCU on March 6, but took a no decision in a 10-inning win by TCU. Tepesch allowed three runs, two of which were earned, on six hits in the game. After allowing a single to open the game, Tepesch retired six of the next seven batters he faced, with the only base runner reaching on an error. In the fifth inning, TCU put one run on the board and had runners on second and third before Tepesch struck out the next two batters to end the inning. In his start against Xavier, he left following just one inning of work after he was hit by a batted ball in the top of the first inning. Tepesch returned against North Dakota on March 19 and struck out eight in six innings pitched. He did not allow a run and gave up just three hits to earn the win and move to 2-0 on the year. In the Big 12 opener, Tepesch turned in a season-long 7.1 innings pitched (two outs shy of his career long eight IP) against Texas A&M, striking out four. Tepesch came within just one out of pitching his first career complete game last Saturday against Baylor when he struck out five in 8.2 innings pitched in the game, but took the loss.

NEWCOMERS MAKE A QUICK IMPACT

The roster for Missouri is loaded with new names in 2010. A total of 17 players have seen their first playing time for Missouri this season. Freshman Brannon Champagne, Dane Opel, Blake Brown, Kale Gaden and Eric Garcia have combined to make 83 starts and junior college transfer Brett Nicholas has started 27 of MU's 268 games on the year. Nicholas is the team's third leading hitter with a .363 average and leads the team with 34 RBI. Garcia is fourth on the squad with a .318 average and Opel is hitting .313. On the mound, freshman Eric Anderson has started five games for the Tigers. He is 1-1 on the season and is second on the squad with 24 strikeouts. Anderson picked up a win in his first collegiate start against Florida Atlantic on Feb. 28 when he struck out five and did not allow a run in five innings pitched. Junior Zack Hardoin, a transfer from Blinn College, has made 15 appearances, which is second on the team, and has two starts. He picked up the win on Feb. 20 against Washington with a scoreless inning of work in relief and started the first game of the March 19 doubleheader with North Dakota. JAMIESON STANDS SECOND ON MU'S ALL-TIME WINS LIST

Mizzou Head Coach Tim Jamieson stands in second place on Mizzou's all-time wins list with a career record of 532-367-2 in his 16th year as the Tigers' head coach. His 532 wins put him ahead of legendary former head coach John "Hi" Simmons. Simmons compiled a record of 481-294-3 from 1937-1973, while Gene McArtor is the all-time winningest coach at Missouri with a record of 733-430-3 from 1974-1994. Jamieson, who served as an assistant coach under McArtor from 1988-94, has led the Tigers to seven NCAA Regionals, including each of the last six and is a two-time Conference Coach of the Year. In 2008, the University of Missouri extended Jamieson's contract, keeping him in the MU dugout through at least the 2013 season. Jamieson and Baylor coach Steve Smith are now the longest tenured coaches in the Big 12 Conference, as each is in his 16th year as head coach of the respective programs. In addition, with the resignation of Mizzou Swimming Coach Brian Hoffer and the upcoming retirement of MU Track & Field Coach Rick McGuire, Jamieson will become the longest tenured head coach at the University of Missouri.

SENNE NAMED BIG 12 PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Senior Aaron Senne was named the Big 12 Conference Player of the Week on March 1. Senne hit .462 (6-for-13) in the Tigers' three games at the Auburn Classic, including three home runs and two doubles. He drove in six runs on the week and had a slugging percentage of 1.308. Senne had a double in the opener of the Auburn Classic against Florida Atlantic, driving in one run. Against Auburn, Senne hit two home runs and had four RBI. His first homer was a two-run shot in the third inning and his second was the second of back-to-back home runs for Mizzou in the fifth. He closed the weekend with a 2-for-4 performance against Boston College, with a home run and a double.

TIGERS PICKED EIGHTH IN BIG 12 POLL

The Big 12 Conference Preseason Coaches' poll was released prior to the season with Missouri coming in tied for eighth in the voting conducted by the league's coaches. The Tigers tied with Nebraska with 22 points in the poll. Texas was atop the poll, garnering 81 points and nine first place votes. The last time the Tigers were picked eighth in the preseason poll was in 2007. They finished second that season and hosted an NCAA Regional. Mizzou was also picked eighth in the 2005 preseason poll, but finished fourth place that year.

TIGERS TO PLAY IN THREE MAJOR LEAGUE STADIUMS IN 2010

Missouri has games scheduled in three Major League stadiums during the 2010 season, starting with Houston College Classic at Minute Maid Park, home of the Houston Astros, earlier this year. In addition, the Tigers will play in both of the MLB stadiums in Missouri, starting with an April 7 contest against Illinois at Busch Stadium, home of the St. Louis Cardinals. Two weeks after that, MU will face Kansas in a non-conference game at Kauffman Stadium, home of the Kansas City Royals on April 21. This will mark the second-straight year that Missouri has played at Busch Stadium (defeating Saint Louis University 19-6 in 2009) and the third year MU and KU will meet at Kauffman Stadium.

BASEBALL WELL REPRESENTED
IN MISSOURI ATHLETICS HALL OF FAME CLASS OF 2009

This past January, the Class of 2009 was inducted into the Missouri Intercollegiate Hall of Fame. Included in that class was the 1964 Baseball team, along with Ryan Fry, who played baseball at MU from 1995-98. The 1964 team was the National runners-up, finishing the year 27-5-1, winning its last 21 games of the season. The Tigers were a perfect 19-0 in the Big Eight, claiming their fourth-straight conference title. That squad led the nation with a 0.65 ERA, an NCAA record that still stands today. The 1964 team became the fourth team inducted in the Missouri Intercollegiate Athletics Hall of Fame, and the second baseball team. The 1964 team joins the 1954 National Champion Baseball team in the Hall of Fame, making baseball the first program to have multiple teams in the Hall.

Fry is the 25th baseball individual to go into the Hall and is still near the top of several lists in the Mizzou record books. Named a Second Team All-American in 1998, Fry was also a standout in the classroom, twice earning Academic All-American honors (1997, 1998). He was a three-time Academic All-Big 12 selection.

Junior Kyle Gibson struck out 15 batters, one off his career high, but took the loss as Missouri fell to No. 10 Oklahoma by a score of 2-1. Gibson went the full nine innings, picking up his third complete game of the year. He gave up two runs on six hits and walked just one. Gibson retired the first 11 OU batters of the game and faced the minimum through the first four innings. He struck out the side in order in the third and eighth innings. Oklahoma put the first runs of the game on the board in the top of the fifth inning, getting three-straight hits. Mizzou's run came in the bottom of the sixth inning when senior Ryan Lollis singled to drive in freshman Ryan Gebhart. Gebhart had led off the sixth by reaching on wild pitch on strike three. Oklahoma starter Andrew Doyle struck out six in eight innings of work, allowing one run on four hits. He moved to 4-2 with the win. Lollis provided a highlight reel catch in the bottom of the eighth inning, as he stole a home run from OU's Aaron Baker. Lollis leaped, reached over the wall and pulled what would have been a two-run homer back. He then doubled off Bryant Hernandez at second. Senior Steve Gray had two of Missouri's four hits on the night, finishing 2-for-3 in the game.

OKLAHOMA 7, MISSOURI 4
April 4, 2009 -- Columbia, Mo.

No. 10 Oklahoma scored four runs in the top of the fifth inning and took a 7-4 win over Missouri. The Sooners scored first, putting two runs on the board in the second inning with both runs scoring on a single by Kaleb Herren. Mizzou scored three times in the bottom of the third inning which started with a lead off home run by senior Kyle Mach. The homer was his first of the season. Junior Michael Liberto followed with a single and senior Ryan Lollis was hit by a pitch. Junior Trevor Coleman then doubled to drive in Liberto and Lollis would score on a sacrifice fly by junior Greg Folgia. The Sooners regained the lead with a four-run top of the fifth. OU batted around in the fifth and got RBI hits from Garrett Buechele and Casey Johnson. In the bottom the fifth inning, Folgia hit his team-leading fourth home run of the season. The solo shot pulled Mizzou within two runs. OU added a run in the ninth as Aaron Baker led off the inning with a home run to give the Sooner the three-run advantage. The Tigers used the pitcher-by-committee on Saturday, sending 10 pitchers to the mound. Missouri has now used the planned staff pitching effort nine times this season and this loss was just the second when the staff pitching is utilized.

MISSOURI 5, OKLAHOMA 4
April 5, 2009 -- Columbia, Mo.

Mizzou closed its three-game series with No. 10 Oklahoma by taking a 5-4 win. Missouri scored all five of its in the bottom of the second inning, highlighted by a two-run single by junior Aaron Senne and an RBI double off the bat of junior Greg Folgia. Oklahoma put a run across the plate in the third inning, added a run in the fifth and scored twice in the top of the seventh inning, which included a lead off home run by Garrett Buechele. OU threatened to add more runs in the late innings, but the Mizzou bullpen came through in the clutch. Sophomore Tyler Clark came on in relief with two on and two outs in the seventh and struck out Bryant Hernandez to end the inning. The Sooners again put the tying run on base in the eighth, but sophomore Phil McCormick came out of the bullpen to strike out Trey Sperring for the final out of the inning. Sophomore Brad Buehler pitched a scoreless ninth inning to pick up his third save of the season. Senior Scooter Hicks also pitched 0.2 scoreless innings in relief. Combined, the Tiger bullpen did not give up a run and allowed just two hits in three innings of work. MU starter Nick Tepesch struck out nine in six innings pitched, allowing four runs on six hits. He took the win to move to 2-2 on the season.
