CONFERENCE NOTES

Weekly Honors

• *Player of the Week:* Aneesah Morrow set new season-highs in points and recorded double-double during both games at the Cayman Islands Classic. She averaged 32.5 points and 13.0 rebounds per game in two games on the island to earn a spot on the All-Tournament team. In the first game against Niagara she had 28 points to go with 10 rebounds and added five steals. It was her third time in four games to record 5+ steals. It was her 14th game in her career with 25+ pts, 10+ rebs, and 5+ steals; over the past 25 seasons no other player has six games with those stats. Against Virginia she led the Tigers to a three-point victory with 37 points and 16 rebounds, stepping up as LSU lost Sa'Myah Smith a day earlier with a knee injury. It was her second career game with at least 35 points and 15 rebounds.

• *Co-Freshman of the Week:* Essence Cody picked up her first career double-double and first one of the season for Alabama during the Betty Chancellor Classic in Katy, Texas during Thanksgiving weekend. Cody picked up back-to-back double-digit games against Gonzaga on Nov. 25 (13) and Liberty on Nov. 26 (10). She also had 11 rebounds against Gonzaga, five in the ranked win over Louisville and seven against Liberty. She averaged 8.6 points, 7.6 rebounds and 1.3 blocks over three games last week. The freshman has started every game for the Crimson Tide and leads the team in rebounds with 60 and blocks with 10.

Taliah Scott led the Hogs through two games at the Elevance Health Fort Myers Tip-Off, averaging nearly 20.0 points with 4.0 rebounds per game over the weekend. Scott put up 18 points and five boards against Wisconsin along with a career-high four 3-pointers. She followed that up with a 20-piece vs. Marquette, her fourth 20-point game in her young career, with 21 points off 6-of-13 shooting from the field. Scott went on a streak of 23 consecutive free throws made until missing just one in eight attempts vs. the Golden Eagles. Through three weeks of the season, Scott leads the SEC in scoring with 23.14 points per game and is fourth in free throw percentage at .875 with the most free throw makes and attempts in the league.

Around the League

- The inaugural ACC/SEC Men's and Women's Basketball

Challenge events – matching the ACC and SEC men's and women's college basketball teams against one another, will be featured across ESPN platforms this week.

- The challenge was split 7 games for each league.

• LSU's Morrow was named the Associated Press Player of the Week as well as one of the five Ann Meyers Drysdale National Player of the Week by the USBWA.

• Former LSU star Seimone Augustus was announced as a 2024 Women's Basketball Hall of Fame inductee. The induction ceremony will be in April.

• In the comeback win over North Carolina, the Gamecocks shot their best from behind the arc so far this season, finishing 6-for-11 (54.5%) with newcomer Te-Hina Paopao and Bree Hall accounting for three each.

• In the overtime win over Boston College, Kentucky's Eniya Russell, led with a career-high 21 points. It marked the second game this season and the second game in her career she has led Kentucky in scoring. She also made a career-high seven free throws on 7-of-9 at the line. She added four rebounds, a career-high tying four assists and two steals.

• Janiah Barker led the Aggies in scoring for the fourth time this season, pouring in 14 points on 7-of-11 from the field in the win over Wake Forest. A&M is 3-1 this year when Barker leads the team in points.

2024 SEC TOURNAMENT

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2018, 2022), Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009, 2015), Greenville, S.C. (2005, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2023, 2024), Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010, 2013, 2014) and Jacksonville, Fla. (2016).

The winner of the tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 31 of the conference tournament champions have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. Four of the last 14 SEC Tournament champions have gone on to win the national championship. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only twice.

Tennessee leads the league with 17 SEC Tournament titles. South Carolina is second with eight, Vanderbilt has six, while Auburn, Georgia, each have four. LSU has two with Kentucky, Mississippi State and Texas A&M having each won one SEC Tournament championship.

Tie-Break Procedure

Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings. Teams that finished No. 1 through No. 4 in the final regular season standings shall receive first- and second-round byes and teams that finish No. 5 through No. 10 will receive first-round byes.

1. Two-Team Tie: The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

A) Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.

B) Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).

C) Coin flip by the Commissioner.

2. Three-Team Tie (or more): Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).

A) Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).

B) Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).

C) If two teams remain, coin flip by the Commissioner.

D) If three or more teams remain, draw by the Commissioner.

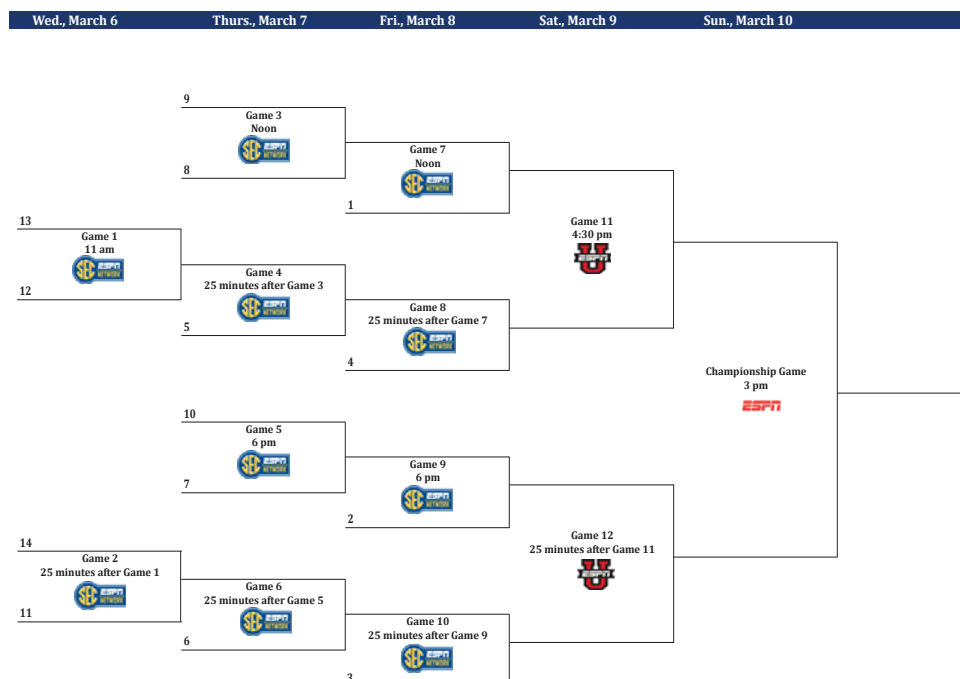
For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will

automatically be seeded last. The No. 11 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.

SEC SUCCESS

- With 11 national championships, 12 runner-up finishes, a nation-leading 42 Final Four appearances and 167 first-team All-America honors, the SEC stands firmly as the nation's premier intercollegiate women's basketball conference.
- Twelve of the current SEC coaches have led teams to the NCAA Tournament.
- Four SEC coaches have been head coaches in the Final Four with two winning national championships.
- Five current SEC coaches have both played and coached in the NCAA Tournament (Katie Abrahamson-Henderson, Kyra Elzy, Kellie Harper, Kim Mulkey and Dawn Staley).
- The SEC has had at least one student-athlete named as a First-Team All-America selection in each of the last 15 seasons.
- All-Americans were first named in women's basketball in 1975. Since that time, league schools have had 80 players named first-team a total of 167 times.
- The SEC has had 159 former players play in the WNBA.
- In this year's WNBA draft, a total of nine SEC women's basketball players were taken.
- Since the inaugural WNBA draft in 1997, the SEC has had 189 former players drafted for the professional league, including seven No. 1 picks.
- The SEC has had a first round pick every year except one (2014).
- Since the SEC began to sponsor women's basketball in 1982, it has failed only five times to place at least four members in each of the final polls (the USA Today/ESPN poll began in 1986).
- The most SEC teams in the final AP poll is seven, which the league has done four times (1996, 1997, 2003, and 2018).
- Overall, the league teams have been ranked every week except for the very first poll in 1976.
- The league has had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week three in 2005 and in week eight in 1989.
- A total of 103 women's basketball students were named to the 2022-23 SEC Academic Honor Rolls for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- The conference has had 36 women's basketball players named Academic All-American.
- SEC schools have produced 45 Team USA Olympians since 1976, with 41 coming since the SEC began sponsoring women's basketball. In addition, seven have played for other countries in the Olympics.
- SEC teams have won 468 NCAA Tournament games against 249 losses (.653) for an average of 11.4 NCAA wins per year.

Attendance

• SEC women's basketball set the all-time NCAA record for conference leaders in total attendance. A total of 1,146,341 fans passed through its turnstiles during home games and conference tournament action. Overall, the league has five of the Top 10 total attendance seasons.

• The SEC has led the nation in women's basketball average attendance for seven of the last eight seasons.

SEC vs Everyone Else

• In regular season games, the SEC has compiled a 5932-1733 (.774) record against other conferences.

• In the postseason, SEC teams are 544-249 (.653) against non-conference teams. Overall, teams are 6393-1959 (.765).

• The league has recorded 150+ wins in 28 seasons and has recorded a non-conference winning percentage below .700 only once.
