SERIES BREAKDOWN

Mizzou women's basketball will face Illinois at 6 p.m. CT on Wednesday. The Tigers enter the contest on a five-game win streak following a victory over SIUE on Sunday. Mizzou trails the all-time series 10-7 all-time and is 5-2 in contests in Mizzou Arena.

PREGAME PRESS

- Four Tigers scored in double figures for the eighth time this season against SIUE
- Dowell and Grace Slaughter are the first Mizzou duo to score in double figures in the first 11 games of a season in program history
- Dowell has scored in double-figures in 25 straight games dating back to last season
- Mizzou has outscored its opponents by 48 points in the fourth-quarter this season
- Shannon Dowell is tied for 17th in the country with four double-doubles this season
- Mizzou ranks sixth in the SEC and 25th in the country in field-goal percentage at 47.3%
- Slaughter and Dowell rank fourth and ninth in the SEC with 19.2 and 17.1 points per game this season
- As a team, Mizzou is third in the conference and seventh in the country in 3-point percentage at 40.3%
- Mizzou has assisted on 73-76 of its 3-point makes this season
- Dowell is tied for eighth in the country with 71 free-throws made this season
- Mizzou leads the SEC and is 15th in the country free-throw percentage at 80.19%
- On Nov. 12, Missouri signed three top-100 recruits in Natalya Hodge (No. 54), Khloe Ford (No. 94) and Jada Maples (No. 95) in addition to Cecile Brandimore and Ellie Mueller
- Grace Slaughter scored her 1,000th career point against the Northwestern on Nov. 29

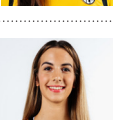

NOTING THE TIGERS

DOWELL ON DISPLAY

- Shannon Dowell attempted the most free-throws (23) in program history in season opener against Central Arkansas.
- Dowell was the first Tiger to lead the team in scoring in their Mizzou debut since Sophie Cunningham did so against Missouri State on Nov. 13, 2015.
- Dowell (12) and Jordana Reisma (13) are the first Tigers to have 10+ rebounds since Mizzou vs Belmont on Nov. 6, 2023
- On Nov. 6 against Tulane, Dowell recorded her 1,000th-career point
- Dowell scored 30 points and grabbed four rebounds against Southern Illinois on Nov. 18.
- Dowell has notched double-digit points in every game this season and has scored in double-figures in 20 straight contests, dating back to last season.
- Dowell was 10-of-10 at the free throw line on Tuesday. For the first time in Mizzou program history two Tigers have been perfect from the charity strip with 10+ attempts in a single season after Grace Slaughter made 12 attempts against Tulane on Nov. 6.
- Dowell scored 20 points in the first half against Troy (Nov. 20), marking the first time a Mizzou player scored at least 20 in a half since Sophie Cunningham dropped 21 in the opening half of the team's game against Auburn on Jan. 27, 2019

HARPER AT THE HELM

- In March, Harper was hired as the fifth coach in program history
- Upon her hiring, in 20 seasons as a Division I head coach, Harper has led her teams to a 393-260 record with nine NCAA Tournament berths. She has piloted her squads to 15 top-three league finishes and four conference tournament championships.
- Harper is one of two coaches in women's college basketball history to guide four different programs to the NCAA Tournament.
- Harper was a three-time national champion while playing under legendary head coach Pat Summitt at Tennessee (1995-99)
- Familiar with the region, Harper was the head coach at Missouri State from 2013-19, where she led the Lady Bears to two NCAA Tournament appearances, including a run to the Sweet 16 in 2019.

- Harper produced four straight first-round picks in the WNBA Draft from (2021-24)
- Developed eight All-SEC honorees
- Coached three players to SEC All-Freshman honors

THE SLAUGHTERHOUSE

- Grace Slaughter scored her 1,000th career point in a career-high 33-point performance against Northwestern on Nov. 29
- Grace Slaughter tied Lisa Plummer, Tracy Ellis, Cierra Porter, Hayley Frank and Sophie Cunningham as the only Tigers in program history to convert 100 percent at the line with 10 or more attempts against (12-12) Tulane (Nov. 6)
- Slaughter ranked 18th in scoring in the SEC, with 15.0 points per game
- Slaughter was named to the Cheryl Miller Small Forward of the Year Preseason Watch List on Oct. 29
- Slaughter was named the 2024-25 SEC Scholar Athlete of the Year
- She ranked sixth in the SEC with a 61.5 true shooting percentage and fifth in the conference with a 56.8 effective field-goal percentage in 2024-25.
- Slaughter ranked third in the SEC for free-throw percentage at 85.8 percent
- Her career free-throw percentage of 84.6 ranks second in Mizzou program history behind Hayley Frank (2019-24)
- She scored in double figures in 26 contests last season
- As a freshman, Slaughter was the first Mizzou player since Sophie Cunningham to record a double-double in the first game as a Tiger with 10 points and 10 rebounds against Belmont (11/6/23)
- She was ranked as the No. 53 overall recruit and No. 1 in the state of Missouri out of Grain Valley High School

THE SCOUT

- Illinois finished last season 22-10, ending 5th in the Big Ten Conference.
- The Illini are coached by Shauna Green, who is in her fourth season at the helm.
- Green led Illinois to 63 wins in her first three seasons with the team, marking the most by a head coach in their first three years at Illinois and matching the program's record of wins in three years.
- The Illini are headlined by sophomore forward Berry Wallace, who posted 20+ points in the first four games of the season

NOTING THE TIGERS

- for Illinois.
- Freshman forward Cearah Parchment posted her fourth double-double of the season with 15 points and 13 rebounds against Indiana.
- The nickname “fighting Illini” was adopted to honor the state’s native american history, and as a tribute to alumni, staff and students who died during World War I.

INJURY REPORT

- On November 3, Mizzou announced that redshirt junior point guard would miss the entirety of the 2025-26 season with a torn ACL
- Mizzou has been without Hannah Linthacum and Sydney Mains this season due to injuries

SIGNING DAY SUCCESS

- Missouri signed three top-100 recruits in Natalya Hodge (No. 54), Khloe Ford (No. 94) and Jada Maples (No. 95) in addition to Cecilie Brandimore and Ellie Mueller on national signing day
- Hodge:** A four-star prospect out of Bearden High School in Knoxville, Tennessee ... Ranked fifth among all point guards in the country, Hodge averaged 25.7 points per game as a junior in 2024-25 ... She has already scored over 2,000 points in her prep career.
- Ford:** A four-star prospect out of Hoover High School in Birmingham, Alabama ... A dynamic 6-foot-4 forward, Ford led Hoover to a 32-4 record and captured the program's fifth-straight state championship
- Maples:** the No. 29 shooting guard in the country out of Earle High School in Earle, Arkansas ... poured in 31 points, 20 rebounds and seven steals in the 2025 state championship game
- Brandimore:** 6-foot-4 forward out of Franklin High School in Franklin, Tennessee, averaged 24.9 points, 13.6 rebounds and three blocks as a junior
- Mueller:** 6-foot-3 forward out of high school powerhouse Dowling Catholic in West Des Moines, Iowa, is ranked the No. 5 prospect in the state by Prep Hoops Iowa.

POSTGAME NOTES

- Against Arkansas State, Reisma (13) and Dowell (12) were the first Tigers to have 10+ rebounds since Grace Slaughter (10) and Ashton Judd (10) vs Belmont on Nov. 6, 2023
- Mizzou posted 33 points in the third quarter

- against Arkansas State, the most points in a quarter since Nov. 28, 2021 against Lehigh (36)
- Shannon Dowell opened scoring one second into play at 09:59 against Southern Illinois (Nov. 3). Dowell’s three points are the fastest opening score this season.

FACILITY NOTES

- Built in 2004, Mizzou Arena has served as home to Missouri men's and women's basketball ever since.
- For nearly two decades Mizzou Arena has been one of the country's top home-court venues thanks to the state-of-the-art facilities, locker rooms and a full-length practice gym which is open to Tigers student-athletes 24/7.
- With a capacity over 15,000, Norm Stewart Court has become one of the toughest road venues in the SEC.
- Ahead of the 2023-24 season, Mizzou Athletics completed renovations to the arena that included a new video board, and brand new seats that were switch from gold to black.
- The video board measures 16.4 feet by 24.6 feet. It also has two 5.75-foot by 16.4-foot underbelly displays.
- New LED lighting has been installed to enhance both the in-person and broadcast viewing of contests
- A state-of-the-art projector system has been implemented to greatly enhance pregame entertainment. The projection will create a three-dimensional look on the court.
- In 2021, new locker rooms for both teams were finished. The locker rooms included updated player lounges, private taping bays, dressing rooms and film rooms. The project also added audio, visual, and equipment charging stations as well as gaming equipment.
- Prior to the 2018-2019 season a complete remake of the Mizzou coaching offices was

finished. Entryways and offices were renovated, providing fresh graphics and redesigns suited for the needs of the men's and women's basketball staffs.

- Mizzou Arena is also home to a private Athletic Performance Center, built specifically to train basketball athletes. The performance center has strength training and cardio equipment designed specifically by the strength staff to maximize student-athletes abilities on and off the court.
- Across the hall from the performance center holds the Mizzou Athletic Training room. The training room comes complete with aqua therapy and hydro pools, as well as treatment tables and offices for Mizzou Sports Medicine.
- Nutritional needs can also be met at Mizzou Arena, as both locker rooms have nutrition stations to enhance the recovery of the student-athletes.
- During the offseason, Mizzou Arena serves as Central Missouri's market venue for concerts, high school state championships, and many other events.
- On Oct. 21, it was announced that five of six Mizzou gymnastics competitions in 2026

A PROVEN WINNER

A proven winner with a deep-rooted history of success in high-major college basketball, Kellie Harper was hired as head coach of Missouri women's basketball on March 18, 2025

Harper brings a championship pedigree at the sport's highest level, including 16 postseason appearances in 20 seasons as a Division I head coach, including nine appearances in the NCAA Tournament.

Harper, who becomes the fifth coach in Mizzou program history, is a decorated leader with extensive experience in the Southeastern Conference as both a coach and student-athlete. With an established track record of recruiting and developing elite talent, Harper is one of two coaches in women's college basketball history to guide four different programs to the NCAA Tournament.

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

A staunch presence on the recruiting trail, Harper signed the No. 15-ranked class in 2021 and inked the nation's No. 6 ranked transfer portal class in 2023, as rated by 247Sports. Harper has established a track record for recruiting elite players across the Midwest and throughout the SEC footprint.

While at Tennessee, Harper coached four WNBA first-round picks in Rennia Davis (2021), Rae Burrell (2022), Jordan Horston (2023) and Rickea Jackson (2024). She is one of only three coaches all-time to produce four straight first-round picks in the WNBA Draft. She joined Connecticut's Geno Auriemma (2008-11, 2013-16) and Notre Dame's Muffet McGraw (2012-15) in that company.

THE HARPER RESUME

Spending five years with the Lady Vols, Harper rebuilt the historic program to national prominence. Two of her last three teams won 25 games, including a 25-9 record in 2021-22 with an 11-5 mark in SEC play and a 25-12 record in 2022-23 with a 13-3 mark against league competitors. The Lady Vols' 13 SEC wins in 2022-23 were the program's most since 2014-15 as they recorded 25 victories in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 2013-14 and 2014-15.

With roots in the Show-Me state, Harper took the reins at Tennessee after six years at Missouri State, where she led the Lady Bears to two NCAA Tournament appearances, including an impressive march to the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament championship and magical run to the NCAA Sweet 16 in 2018-19.

Prior to her arrival at Missouri State, Harper became just the third women's basketball coach in North Carolina State history in 2009 and directed the Wolfpack to three postseason appearances and a 70-64 record during her four-year stint, including the 2010 NCAA Tournament.

Before her tenure in Raleigh, Harper guided Western Carolina to a 97-65 record and four postseason berths in five seasons, including a 70-31 mark in her final three years in Cullowhee.

Prior to her first head coaching job, Harper spent three seasons as an assistant at Chattanooga, helping the Mocs to three consecutive Southern Conference championships, three NCAA appearances and a combined 78-15 record under head coach Wes Moore.

Before her time in Chattanooga, Harper spent two seasons at Auburn, the first as an administrative assistant before being promoted to assistant coach under Joe Ciampi for the 2000-01 campaign.

PLAYING UNDER PAT

As a student-athlete, Harper was a floor general for legendary coach Pat Summitt at Tennessee from 1995-99, playing 132 games and leading the Lady Vols to NCAA National Championships in 1996, 1997 and 1998. She was part of a senior class that helped the Big Orange forge a 131-17 overall record as well as win two SEC regular-season championships (1998, 1999) and three SEC Tournament crowns (1996, 1998, 1999).

PERSONAL

Harper is married to Jon Harper, an assistant coach on her staffs at Western Carolina, NC State, Missouri State and Tennessee. The Harpers welcomed their first child, son Jackson, in November 2013, and had a daughter, Kiley, in June 2018.

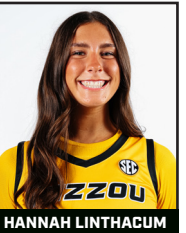
