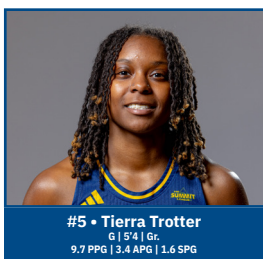
THE STARTING 5

- Kansas City wraps up the 2025-26 non-conference slate with a road clash against cross-state foe Missouri. Last time out, the Roos blew out Haskell 109-59 behind 22 steals as a team, setting a new program record. Five Roos recorded multiple steals in the 50 point win over the Fighting Indians.
- Kansas City's rout of Haskell was headlined by spectacular showings from the Bennett sisters. Elauni Bennett paced the Roos with 27 points and 15 rebounds, her third double-double of the season and seventh of her career. Emani Bennett poured in 25 points, giving her 25-plus in three of KC's last four contests.
- Last time the Roos took down the Tigers was December 8, 2019. Kansas City completed second half comeback to upset Missouri 59-56 in the Swinney Center in a season where the Roos won the WAC championship, the program's lone conference title.
- Dionnah Jackson-Durrett is very familiar with the Tigers, holding a 7-4 career record against Missouri. Jackson-Durrett is 5-3 vs. Mizzou as a coach, dating back to her time as an assistant coach at Mississippi State and 2-1 as a player back at Oklahoma.
- The Roos lead the Summit League in three point shooting efficiency, converting on outside shots at a 40.8% clip this season, ranking second best in the country. On the other end, the Roos force turnovers at a high rate, generating 22.0 turnovers per game and 11.6 steals per game, both Summit best marks and top 50 on the national scene.

SCOUTING THE TIGERS

- Missouri is having a great start to the 2025-26 season under first year HC Kellie Harper. The Tigers are 11-3 and are victors of their last two games with wins over Saint Louis 82-66 and North Alabama 84-57.
- The Tigers are 83rd in the NCAA Net Rankings for the 2025-26 season making Missouri the fifth top 100 opponent Kansas City has faced in the non-conference schedule.
- The Tigers lead the SEC in free throw shooting percentage at 80.7%, ranking eighth in the nation at the charity stripe. Mizzou knocks down 14.9 free throws a game, ranking eighth in the SEC and top 50 in the country.
- Missouri is led in scoring by Grace Slaughter. The 6'2 junior guard averages 19.4 points per game, ranking fourth in the SEC in scoring and 28th in the country. Slaughter also shoots the ball at a 47.1% clip from the field and 39.7% from three point territory.

QUICK HITTERS

Seeing Double

- For the first time in their careers, the Bennett sisters had at least 20 points in the same game.
- Elauni tallied a 27 point, 15 rebound double-double, the seventh of her career and third this season while Emani scored 25 points, the third time in the last four games she's notched 25 or more in scoring.

Chasing 1,000

- In her third season with Kansas City, Emani Bennett is chasing 1,000 career points. The Lee's Summit, Mo. native is currently sitting at 962 points in 76 games played with 67 career starts for KC.
- Bennett is averaging a team-best 17.0 points per game, the fourth leading scorer in the Summit League.
- Bennett has scored 25 points or more in four games this year, including in three of the Roos last four contests with 27 points vs. Portland State and Utah Valley and 25 vs. Haskell.

Toughness>Size

- Kansas City is one of nine schools in NCAA college hoops to have two players who stand under 5'10 to average at least 5.5 RPG.
- For the Roos, Elauni Bennett stands 5'9 and leads the team, hauling in 7.6 rebounds per contest while four-year Roo Zaire Harrell is second on the team in rebounding with 5.7 per game while standing 5'8.

Grit & Grind

- Kansas City specializes in wrecking havoc on opposing offenses, leading the Summit League in steals per game (11.6), turnover margin (5.3) and turnovers per game (22.0), while also being top 50 nationally in each of those categories.
- Kansas City generated 22 steals and 35 turnovers in a 109-59 win over Haskell, the most the Roos have forced in a single game this season.
- Against the Roos four top 100 NET opponents (KU, OU, LU, UARK), Kansas City forced an average of 17 turnovers per game.

Catching Fire

- Kansas City is one of the best three point shooting teams in America, knocking down 40.8% of shots from long range this season which ranks as the best mark in the Summit and is second best in the country.

- The Roos have four games of shooting above the 50% mark from three and seven of 37%-plus shooting from downtown.
- Kansas City is one of two teams in the country (Quinnipiac) to have two three point shooters (Emani Bennett 46.3%, Jamyah Winter 43.4%) shooting 43% from behind the arc or better this season.

Board Woman Gets Paid

- For the second consecutive season, Elauni Bennett leads the Summit League in offensive rebounding, averaging 4.3 offensive boards per game which is 10th in the country.
- Bennett has recorded three double-doubles this season, racking up 18 points and 14 rebounds against William Jewell, 12 points and 10 rebounds vs. Northern Colorado and 25 points and 15 rebounds vs. Haskell.

Trotter's Impact

- UTRGV transfer point guard Tierra Trotter has made a staunch impact on Kansas City this season. The graduate guard leads the team in assists and steals.
- Trotter averages 3.4 assists per game which ranks second in the Summit League. Additionally, Trotter averaged 1.6 steals per game.

Jay's Block Party

- Jumoke Adaramoye threw her own block party against Portland State, recording a career-best six blocks, the most by a Roo in a single game this season.
- Adaramoye's six rejections are the most by a Roo in a single game in two seasons and is nearly double what the team averages, at 3.3 per game.

Winter is Coming

- Kansas City has seen a major impact from graduate transfer Jamyah Winter this season. Winter averages 9.0 PPG while shooting 43.4% from three point range.
- Winter has posted two games of six made three pointers against Lindenwood and Hesston. The Lincoln Memorial transfer has notched a 40%-plus mark from three in six of the Roos 12 games this year.
- Winter is top 50 in the country in total three pointers (33), three pointers per game (2.8) and three point percentage (43.4%) while leading the Summit in those stats.

Historic Performance

- The Roos 121 point outing vs. Hesston tied the single game program record for points while KC's 64 spot in the first half broke the program record for most points in a half.
- Kansas City also scored over 100 points for the third time in the Jackson-Durrett era. The Roos had their third ever game of shooting over 60% from the field and from three, KC's second under Jackson-Durrett.

Preseason Hardware

- Emani Bennett heads into her junior season as a member of the Preseason All-Summit League First Team, the Roos' first since 2021.
- Bennett is the only returning player in the conference to have averaged over 30 minutes per game and 15 points per game last year.
- As a sophomore, Bennett was second on the team in scoring at 15.1 PPG and third in rebounding at 4.5 RPG. Bennett produced eight games of 20-plus points or more.

Key Returners

- Kansas City returns key upperclassmen rotational pieces Kelby Bannerman and Zaire Harrell. The two have made a combined 64 starts for the Roos across the last two seasons.
- In her senior season, Bannerman averaged 6.2 PPG (5th on team), 4.2 RPG (4th on team) and led the squad with 25 blocked shots.
- Harrell averaged 3.9 PPG (6th on team) and 4.0 RPG (5th on team) as a junior. The senior guard is the only player under Jackson-Durrett to have played in all four seasons of her tenure.

Experience Matters

- All told, Kansas City comes into this season as one of the most experienced teams in college basketball.
- The Roos have five graduate students, tied for the second most in NCAA college hoops ahead of the 2025-26 season.
- Additionally, KC is also tied for the second most upperclassmen players in the country with 12, making up 75% of the roster.

Bennett Twins Shine in Rout of Haskell

Elauni Bennett tallied a career-high 27 points, 15 rebounds while Emani Bennett totaled 25 points

KANSAS CITY, Mo. – Kansas City Women's Basketball found the get right game they were looking for Saturday afternoon in a 109-59 win over Haskell Indian Nations to break a five game skid inside the Swinney Center.

Kansas City was led by the Bennett twins, who combined for 52 points and 20 made field goals against the Fighting Indians.

Elauni Bennett recorded a career-high 27 points on 10-17 shooting from the floor and grabbed 15 rebounds, nine of those boards being on the offensive side of the glass.

El. Bennett is the fourth player in program history to notch 27 points and 15 rebounds in a single game since the 2002-03 season.

Her twin sister Emani Bennett tallied 25 points, making it the third time in the last four games Em. Bennett has totaled 25 points or more in a game.

Together, the Bennett twins are the third duo in Roos history to both score 25 points or more in a game since 2002-03 and the first since back in January of the 2024-25 season.

Kansas City found a groove offensively after a slow first few minutes, going on a 21-point unanswered run from 6:36 to the 2:49 mark of the first quarter.

The dominant scoring streak was built off pesky defense with the Roos forcing seven steals in that span as well as efficient shot-making, going 8-11 from the field in the 21-0 run that put KC up 26-8 in the first.

The Roos used a three-point barrage from Em. Bennett and the steady interior presence of El. Bennett, who gobbled up rebounds and used the paint as her own personal layup line, to build a substantial lead.

The Roos strong defense remained for the entirety of the contest, forcing 35 turnovers which was a season-high for the team. Kansas City also converted those 35 turnovers into 52 points of offense and reached 21 fast break points.

The Roos came close to breaking the most ever points scored in a half mark of 64, which the Roos set against Hesston earlier this year.

KC reached 60 points at half and led by a 25 point margin, one that grew up to 50 points by the final buzzer. Another fact of note came in the steals department, where the Roos marked up 22 steals for the game, breaking a program record that stood for 27 years.

In totality, 13 Roos made it on the score sheet for the game, making it the most in a game since 2011. Kansas City shot 49% overall, 38% from three and 79% from the free throw line, making it one of the more well-rounded efficiency games of the year for the team.

Kansas City closes out the non-conference slate on the road against Missouri at 2 p.m. next Sunday.

Dionnah Jackson-Durrett was announced as the head coach of Kansas City Women's Basketball on March 30, 2022 and enters her third season with the Roos in 2024-25. Jackson-Durrett, a former first round WNBA pick and one of the most highly touted up-and-coming coaches in the nation, served as the associate head coach at Texas for two seasons and coached in five consecutive NCAA Elite Eights prior to her arrival in KC.

In 2023-24, the Roos posted a 12-20 record, including a five-game winning streak throughout the month of December. Kansas City won three games in Summit League play, taking the #8 seed into postseason play. Emani Bennett was named to the Summit League All-Freshman Team, while Alayna Contreras and Dominique Phillips earned All-Newcomer Team honors.

In her first year as head coach, Jackson-Durrett took a short-handed and injury-riddled team beyond expectations in the postseason. After winning her first two games as a head coach with victories over Westminster and Tennessee State, the Roos had highlights with an overtime win over Bradley and conference victories over ORU, UND and Omaha. Jackson-Durrett's tutelage of E'Lease Stafford throughout the year led her to earn Summit League Newcomer of the Year and Honorable Mention All-League honors.

Taking the 10-seed into the Summit League Championships, the team made a historic run in March, first defeating Denver on a SportsCenter Top 10 buzzer-beating game-winner by Sanaa' St. Andre. Then, Kansas City became the first double-digit seed to reach the Summit Semifinal round, running past second-seeded North Dakota State.

"I'm honored and ecstatic to be a part of the Kansas City Athletics family," Jackson-Durrett said. "Throughout the process the energy has been amazing, and my decision developed organically. I'm supposed to be here, I feel it in my heart."

A native of St. Louis, Jackson-Durrett has deep ties to basketball within Missouri and the Midwest at large. The 2001 Missouri High School Player of the Year put together an All-American career at Oklahoma before spending five years in the professional ranks. From 2010-22, she made coaching stops at Mississippi State, George Mason and Southeast Missouri State, in addition to her time with the Longhorns.

"We are delighted to have Dionnah as a part of our Kansas City family," Vice Chancellor/Director of Athletics Dr. Brandon Martin said. "Not only does she have impeccable integrity, her basketball acumen and coaching pedigree is unmatched. She is a phenomenal leader and teacher of the nuances of basketball, and a maven of life skill development and championing academic excellence. Dionnah will further elevate our departmental mantra of comprehensive excellence."

No stranger to winning culture, Jackson-Durrett helped lead the Longhorns to 50 wins, a 2022 Big 12 Tournament Title and back-to-back NCAA Elite Eights in her two years as associate head coach. The Longhorns' 2021 Elite Eight appearance was their first since 2016, and the 2022 appearance marked the first back-to-back Elite Eight showings since 1989-90. The Big 12 Tournament win was the program's first since 2003.

Known for her ability as a talent developer and mentor, Jackson-Durrett made her mark on Texas' guard play throughout her two seasons. In 2021-22, each of the Longhorns' top-four scorers played primarily from the guard position.

Highlighting Jackson-Durrett's mentoring ability in 2021-22 was freshman Rori Harmon, who was named Big 12 Freshman of the Year, as well as earning spots on the All-Big 12 Second Team, All-Defensive Team and All-Freshman Team. She averaged 11.4 points per game and broke the program's freshman assist mark, notching AP All-America Honorable Mention, Big 12 Tournament Most Outstanding Player, ESPN W Player of the Week, NCBWA National Freshman of the Week and four-time Big 12 Freshman of the Week honors, and was a candidate for National Freshman of the Year.

"(Jackson-Durrett) will not only add to Kansas City's athletic department on campus, but she and her family will be tremendous in the city and state," Texas Head Coach Vic Schaefer said. "Dionnah understands the impact that a successful women's basketball program can have on a university, a community and a state, and she will work tirelessly to make sure that happens. Kansas City has hit a home run in hiring Coach Jackson-Durrett."

Jackson-Durrett also helped develop Joanne Allen-Taylor into a two-time All-Big 12 honoree and led Aliyah Matharu to her first All-Conference nomination after transferring from Mississippi State. In 2020-21, in addition to Allen-Taylor's All-Big 12 selection, guards Kyra Lambert and Celeste Taylor were named to All-Big 12 teams.
