### MATCH NOTES

#### SERIES BREAKDOWN

Missouri Soccer travels to face ACC opponent Duke at 6 p.m. CT on Thursday in Durham, N.C.. The Tigers cruised past in-state foe SEMO, 5-0, on Sunday. The programs have faced off three times previously with the Blue Devils with Duke controlling the series, 3-0.

#### PREGAME PRESS

- Five separate Tigers scored goals on Thursday, Kylee Simmons, Leah Selm, Monica Brauner, Brianna Buels, Bella Carillo
- Missouri head coach Stefanie Golan played collegiately at Duke appearing in 56 games from 1997-2001 and helped lead the team to four NCAA Tournament appearances. Golan
- Brauner earned the first start of her career against the Redhawks before scoring her first career goal
- Mizzou scored goals two and three just 29 seconds apart, the fifth-fastest time between goals in program history
- The Tiger's fifth goal in the 54th minute against SEMO marked the sixth fastest time in history Mizzou has reached five goals in a contest
- Freshman forward Landis Canada scored her first career goal against Miami on Aug. 29
- Fellow freshman Emily Derucki recorded an assist on Canada's goal, Derucki has played 226 minutes on the year
- Milena Fischer Mizzou's leading scorer with two goals on the early season
- Redshirt junior Bella Hollenbach has started 18 consecutive games for the Tigers dating back to Sept. 3, 2023
- Junior forward Kylee Simmons, who scored her first goal of the season on Thursday, led the Tigers with 11 goals a season ago

NOTING THE TIGERS

TAKING THE PITCH

- Missouri is in its 29th season of soccer in 2024
- Sefanie Golan is in her fourth season at the helm of the program
- The Tigers finished the 2023 campaign with a 5-9-3 record

DEFENDING THE FLAGSHIP

- Missouri trounced in-state foe SEMO, 5-0, on Sept. 8
- Five separate Tigers Kylee Simmons, Leah Selm, Monica Brauner, Brianna Buels, Bella Carillo scored in the contest
- The shutout victory marked the first time Mizzou totaled five goals since another 5-0 triumph over Ole Miss on Sept. 9, 2016.
- Selm and Braunner talled a pair of goals just 29 seconds apart, the gap marks Missouri's fifth-fastest time in history between consecutive goals.
- Carillo netted a goal in the 54th minute, it was the sixth fastest time in program history to reach five goals in a contest

SCOUTING THE OPPONENT

- Duke is 4-1 on the season and continued their four-game win streak after defeating East Tennessee State 5-0 on Sunday. The Blue Devils ended last season 6-7-3 overall, going 2-5-3 during conference play.
- Head coach Robbie Church is in his 24th and final season with the Blue Devils. Church has a record of 297-148-86 during his tenure and has won 126 matches over the past nine seasons.
- Church has led the Blue Devils to 20 NCAA Championship appearances, including three trips to the College Cup.
- Sophomore defender, Cameron Roller, leads the team with six points while four separate Blue Devils have scored two goals so far this season.

ROSTER RELOAD

- The Tigers added six freshmen in the offseason including four from the state of Missouri
- Mizzou also brought in two transfers in junior goalkeeper Kassidy Roshong from West Virginia and junior midfielder Hailey Chambliss from Missouri State

KYLEE'S KINGDOM

- Kylee Simmons led the Tigers with 11 goals a

season ago.

- Her goal total led the SEC while she also finished second in the conference in points with 24
- Simmons was named 2023 First Team All-SEC
- She earned College Player of the Week by United Soccer Coaches, SEC Offensive Player of the Week and Women's Team of the Week by Top Drawer Soccer last year
- Simmons ranked second in the conference in total points with 27

WATCH LIST SZN

- Simmons, Keegan Good, Bella Hollenbach and Rachel Kutella were all named to the 2024 SEC Preseason Watch list on Aug. 14

SUMMER SCENES

- Leah Selm did a week-long internship with NASA's Launch Services Program Student Volunteer Experience during the offseason
- A mechanical engineering major, Selm networked with NASA employees and witnessed a rocket launch

- Dimitri Kaliakin was added an assistant coach.
- Kaliakin came to the Tigers from Georgia Southern
- He has previously served in roles with SMU and Ole Miss
- Kaliakin played collegiately at Washington College

- Kuhbacher played collegiately at Wyoming from 2017-2020

- Program alumni Domi Richardson was signed by the Tampa Bay Sun FC of the USL Super League this offseason. Richardson was the first-ever player signed to the new team.
- 2020 graduate Sarah Luebbert currently plays for Club America of Liga MX Femenil.
- Allie Hess (2014-17) competes for MSV Duisburg of Frauen-Bundesliga in Germany.

LEADING THE WAY

Stefanie Golan, a St. Charles, Missouri native, was named the University of Missouri's second women's soccer head coach in May 2021.

The 2024 season will be Golan's 15th as a head coach and third at Missouri. In 14 seasons, she has totaled a 145-111-42 (.557) career record.

BEFORE THE ROAR

Golan came to Mizzou after spending nine seasons building a championship program at the University of Minnesota.

In nine seasons as head coach at Minnesota (2012-2020), Golan fashioned a 92-64-24 (.578) record with four NCAA Tournament appearances, one Big Ten regular-season title, a pair of Big Ten Tournament championships and eight winning seasons.

Leading the Gophers to the 2018 Big Ten Tournament Title, Golan's squad ran through the tournament without allowing a single goal after entering as the seventh seed. With qualification secured for the NCAA Tournament, Minnesota upset Auburn 2-0 in the first round before falling to the UCLA Bruins in the second round of play.

Golan earned her 100th career win against Utah State on Sept. 8, 2017. The milestone came in the form of a 5-0 defeat of the Aggies in her nine seasons as a head coach.

Named Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2016, Golan led Minnesota to a 16-3-4 record and the program's first sweep of the Big Ten regular-season and tournament titles. The Gophers finished the 2016 campaign ranked in the Top 15 nationally after earning the highest national ranking in program history at No. 8. That squad also boasted the Big Ten Forward of the Year in Simone Kolander and the Big Ten Defender of the Year in Rashida Beal, who earned All-America honors and later drafted by FC Kansas City.

Golan guided the 2015 Gophers to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2010 and a 12-7-3 record. The program was ranked as high as No. 11 during the season, and Kolander earned the first of two Big Ten Forward of the Year honors.

Before moving to the Twin Cities to guide the Minnesota program, Golan sept five and a half years at Army West Point, serving as the associate head coach in 2007 and 2008. In three years as the head coach, 2009-11, she led the team to a 33-18-10 record and the program's second-ever NCAA Tournament appearance in 2011.

After debuting as the Black Knights' head coach in 2009, Golan's 2010 squad registered the program's highest win total since 1996 with its 14-4-3 record. It allowed just six goals on the season en route to a share of the Patriot League's regular-season championship. In her final season at West Point, Army went 12-4-5 and won the 2011 Patriot League Tournament title with a thrilling 2-0 win over arch-rival Navy to earn the second-ever NCAA Tournament appearance in program history.

Prior to joining the Army West Point staff, Golan served as an assistant coach at the University of Pittsburgh and the University of Evansville after launching her career as a graduate assistant at Mercer University. The St. Charles native is an active member of the NSCAA and a former Chair of the NSCAA Great Lakes Region for the organization's All-America Committee.

PINGETON PLAYING DAYS

Golan earned a soccer scholarship to Duke University (Stefanie Kraay), where she played 56 games from 1997-2001 and helped lead the team to four NCAA Tournament appearances. The former Blue Devil earned a Bachelor of Arts in political science in 2001 before adding a master's in sports leadership from Northeastern University in 2012.

FACILITY NOTES

- Audrey J. Walton Track-Soccer Stadium was opened in 1996 following a generous \$1 million donation by Mrs. Walton. In 1998, renovations to the complex increased the maximum seating capacity to 2,500 fans per game.
- As the Tiger program grew in popularity, the stadium warranted another upgrade in a lighting project completed in 2001. Various supporters donated \$160,000 to install a state of the art lighting system. Rejuvenating the facility in 2004, the Mizzou Athletic Department completed a field turf project replenishing the playing field with new Bermuda sod.
- The Audrey J. Walton Track-Soccer Stadium has played host to five conference championships and five NCAA soccer tournaments.
- The Tigers set the Missouri all-time attendance record opening the 2001 home season against Memphis. Playing their first night game, the Tigers welcomed 1,926 fans.
