CONFERENCE NOTES

Weekly Honors

• **Player of the Week:** Te-Hina Paopao tied for team-high scoring honors this week (13.5 ppg) and was named MVP of the Gamecocks' Basketball Hall of Fame Women's Showcase victory over #11/7 Utah. Her defensive effort, which helped hold the nation's most efficient 3-point shooting team to just 25.0 percent from outside, was paired with clutch shooting as the Gamecocks held off the Utes late. Her team-high seven fourth-quarter points included a tough 3 after Utah had pulled within three midway through the quarter and she drew an offensive foul in a five-point game with 56 seconds to go. Paopao opened the game with a field goal and two assists on the Gamecocks first three possessions. Against Morgan State, she did her work early and played just 23 minutes. Her continued hot shooting yielded 12 points, and the Gamecocks scored another 13 points off her five assists. She shot 58.8 percent with a 45.5% three-point percentage. She averaged 13.5 points, 2.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 2.0 steals for the week.

• **Freshman of the Week:** Taliah Scott averaged 30 points per game along with 4.0 rebounds per game across the Hogs' two games this week. She started the week by shooting the ball exceptionally well vs. LA Tech, going 12-of-16 from the field, as well as 5-of-8 from 3-point. Her five triples on Thursday were a career-high at the time. She finished the week with a 31-point performances along with matching a career-high six rebounds. Scott logged 23 points in the first half, and could not be stopped from beyond the arc in the game by logging a career-high six 3-pointers. Scott continues to lead the SEC in scoring with 24.5 points per game, while being the only player in the league to average 20.0+ points per game. The freshman is fifth in the NCAA in points per game and is only behind Caitlin Clark for total points, as Scott has logged 269 points through 11 games.

Around the League

• Jessika Carter finished with a career-high 31 points on an efficient 14-19 from the field and 13 rebounds in 30 minutes in a 91-50 win over Kennesaw State in Mississippi State's lone contest this week. It marked her third double-double of the season, 31st double-double of her career – which ranks second among active SEC players – and the 10th career 20-point 10-rebound performance for Carter.

• Aaliyah Nye led the Crimson Tide to victory over SFA with a season high 22 points and finished with a career-best seven three-pointers which eclipsed 200 career three-pointers for the guard (206).

• Karoline Striplin averaged 23.0 points, 5.5 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 2.0 steals while shooting 51.6 percent from the field, 41.7 percent on three-pointers and 81.8 percent at the charity stripe over two games.

• Jordyn Cambridge led Vanderbilt in scoring (12 pts), rebounding (8 reb), and steals (4) in a 51-39 win at Butler on Dec. 7. Her 12-point outing mark the ninth time in 10 games this season that the guard has scored 10 or more points this season. Cambridge has registered double-digit points in 12 of her last 13 games.

• Georgia's Stefanie Ingram boasted a career high in the second consecutive game with 12 points in the win against Troy this past week. Ingram has made the most of her time in the lineup, knocking in 62 percent of her shots (8-of-13) over the last two contests.

2024 SEC TOURNAMENT

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2018, 2022), Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009, 2015), Greenville, S.C. (2005, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2023, 2024), Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010, 2013, 2014) and Jacksonville, Fla. (2016).

The winner of the tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 31 of the conference tournament champions have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. Four of the last 14 SEC Tournament champions have gone on to win the national championship. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only twice.

Tennessee leads the league with 17 SEC Tournament titles. South Carolina is second with eight, Vanderbilt has six, while Auburn, Georgia, each have four. LSU has two with Kentucky, Mississippi State and Texas A&M having each won one SEC Tournament championship.

Tie-Break Procedure

Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings. Teams that finished No. 1 through No. 4 in the final regular season standings shall receive first- and second-round byes and teams that finish No. 5 through No. 10 will receive first-round byes.

1. Two-Team Tie: The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

A) Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.

B) Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).

C) Coin flip by the Commissioner.

2. Three-Team Tie (or more): Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).

A) Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).

B) Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).

C) If two teams remain, coin flip by the Commissioner.

D) If three or more teams remain, draw by the Commissioner.

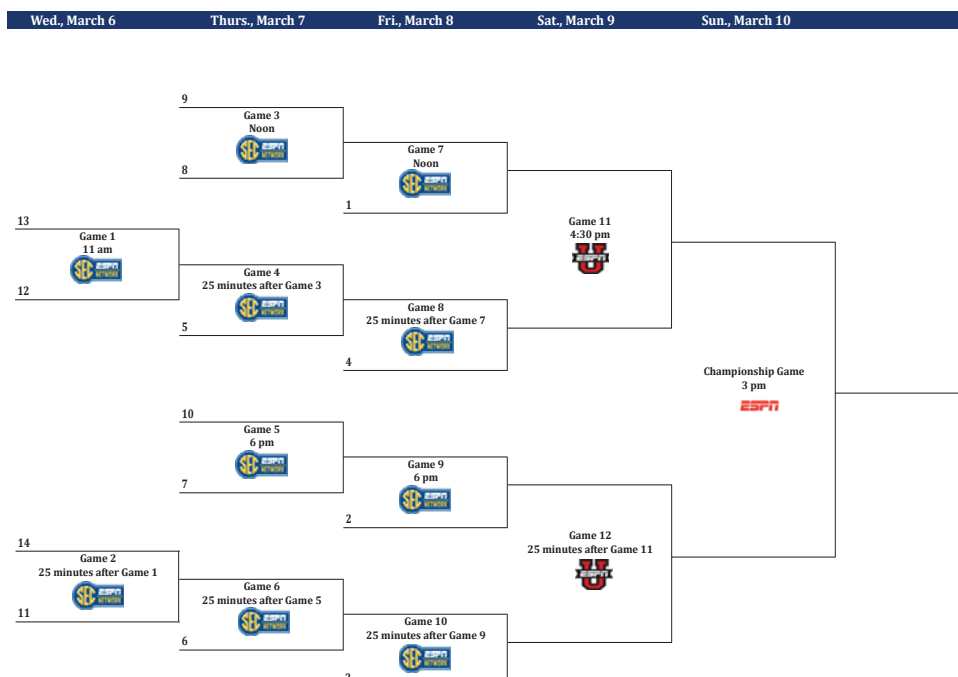
For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will

automatically be seeded last. The No. 11 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.

SEC SUCCESS

- With 11 national championships, 12 runner-up finishes, a nation-leading 42 Final Four appearances and 167 first-team All-America honors, the SEC stands firmly as the nation's premier intercollegiate women's basketball conference.
- Twelve of the current SEC coaches have led teams to the NCAA Tournament.
- Four SEC coaches have been head coaches in the Final Four with two winning national championships.
- Five current SEC coaches have both played and coached in the NCAA Tournament (Katie Abrahamson-Henderson, Kyra Elzy, Kellie Harper, Kim Mulkey and Dawn Staley).
- The SEC has had at least one student-athlete named as a First-Team All-America selection in each of the last 15 seasons.
- All-Americans were first named in women's basketball in 1975. Since that time, league schools have had 80 players named first-team a total of 167 times.
- The SEC has had 159 former players play in the WNBA.
- In this year's WNBA draft, a total of nine SEC women's basketball players were taken.
- Since the inaugural WNBA draft in 1997, the SEC has had 189 former players drafted for the professional league, including seven No. 1 picks.
- The SEC has had a first round pick every year except one (2014).
- Since the SEC began to sponsor women's basketball in 1982, it has failed only five times to place at least four members in each of the final polls (the USA Today/ESPN poll began in 1986).
- The most SEC teams in the final AP poll is seven, which the league has done four times (1996, 1997, 2003, and 2018).
- Overall, the league teams have been ranked every week except for the very first poll in 1976.
- The league has had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week three in 2005 and in week eight in 1989.
- A total of 103 women's basketball students were named to the 2022-23 SEC Academic Honor Rolls for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- The conference has had 36 women's basketball players named Academic All-American.
- SEC schools have produced 45 Team USA Olympians since 1976, with 41 coming since the SEC began sponsoring women's basketball. In addition, seven have played for other countries in the Olympics.
- SEC teams have won 468 NCAA Tournament games against 249 losses (.653) for an average of 11.4 NCAA wins per year.

Attendance

• SEC women's basketball set the all-time NCAA record for conference leaders in total attendance. A total of 1,146,341 fans passed through its turnstiles during home games and conference tournament action. Overall, the league has five of the Top 10 total attendance seasons.

• The SEC has led the nation in women's basketball average attendance for seven of the last eight seasons.

SEC vs Everyone Else

• In regular season games, the SEC has compiled a 5953-1744 (.773) record against other conferences.

• In the postseason, SEC teams are 544-249 (.653) against non-conference teams. Overall, teams are 6393-1959 (.765).

• The league has recorded 150+ wins in 28 seasons and has recorded a non-conference winning percentage below .700 only once.
