QUICK HITTERS

- ▶ The Mizzou gymnastics team returns to competition on Friday, Feb. 12 when the team hosts No. 19 Auburn at 8 p.m. CT at the Hearnes Center. The meet will be televised live on SEC Network with Courtney Lyle and Bridget Sloan calling the action.
- ▶ Last time out, Mizzou fell to No. 1 Florida, 197.850-194.800, on Jan. 29.
- ▶ The Tigers opened the meet against the Gators with a season-high 49.050 on bars, thanks to a season-best 9.9 by sophomore **Sienna Schreiber**.
- ▶ Against Kentucky on Jan. 22, the Tigers closed the meet with a 49.250 on floor, the team's highest score on any event this season, thanks to six scores of 9.8 or higher.
- ▶ Sophomore **Sienna Schreiber** claimed the bars and beam titles against the Wildcats. She now has three event titles on the season and five total in her Missouri career.
- ▶ On Jan. 15 the Tigers fell to No. 4 Alabama by the closest of margins, 195.775-195.750.
- ▶ The Tigers finished the night with a 49.075 on floor but ended up 0.025 short of tying the Tide.
- ▶ Junior **Hannah McCrary** concluded Mizzou's night against the Crimson Tide with a career-high-tying 9.925 on floor, which was good enough to earn her the event title, the fourth of her Tiger career.
- ▶ Schreiber took home the beam title in the meet against the GymDogs after a career-high 9.9 on the apparatus.
- ▶ Missouri sat ranked No. 14 nationally in March 2020 when the season was abruptly cut short prior to the final regular season meet. The Tigers also ended the 2020 season ranked 10th nationally on vault (49.225), 14th on beam (49.200), 18th on floor (49.290) and 24th on bars (49.110).
- ▶ Mizzou will have 63 percent of routines from a year ago available for the 2021 season.
- ▶ Overall, Mizzou returns 68 percent of its floor lineup, 65 percent of its vault and beam lineup and 55 percent of its bars lineup.
- ▶ Head Coach Shannon Welker is in his eighth season at the helm of the Tigers. Last season, Mizzou defeated No. 11 Minnesota and No. 19 Nebraska and twice posted team scores among the top 10 in program history.

Eighth Season at Mizzou

Entering his eighth season at the helm of the Mizzou gymnastics program, Head Coach Shannon Welker continues to make the Tigers a rising power nationally.

In 2020, Welker's Tigers vaulted up the rankings as the season progressed, reaching 14th in late March when the season was abruptly cut short prior to the regular season finale. Over the course of the season, Mizzou defeated No. 11 Minnesota and No. 19 Nebraska and twice posted team scores among the top 10 in program history. Additionally, Welker's vault squad notched two scores that ranked in the program's top 10 on the event.

The Tigers' National Qualifying Score (NQS) of 196.635 at the time the season ended was the third-best such score in program history and the team's highest since 2004. Freshman Helen Hu emerged as one of the nation's top gymnasts, claiming NACGC/W All-America first team (beam) and second team (bars) honors, as well as SEC Event Specialist of the Year accolades.

The 2019 Tigers finished 17th in the national rankings, which tied the team's best finish since 2010. At the 2019 NCAA Athens Regional, Missouri tallied both the highest regional score (196.625) and the top regional beam total (49.200) in program history. Senior Brooke Kelly Senior Brooke Kelly became the 10th Tiger to earn an individual berth to the NCAA Championships after she qualified on beam. Mizzou knocked off four top 25 teams during the 2019 season, including a win over No. 10 Kentucky and a tie with No. 7 Michigan. The Tigers also recorded the second-highest beam score in program history (49.425), the sixth (49.425) and seventh (49.400) best floor scores and the ninth-best vault total (49.275) over the course of the campaign.

Welker's fifth season at Mizzou saw the Tigers knock off three top 10 teams during the regular season. On March 2, Missouri defeated No. 5 Florida, 196-925-196.925, for the first victory over the Gators in program history. Mizzou also defeated Arkansas twice this year while the Razorbacks were ranked in the top 10. Overall, the Tigers went 9-7 in the regular season, including conference wins over No. 5 Florida and No. 10 Arkansas. The squad also concluded the year ranked 20th in the nation, the third-straight season Mizzou ended the year in the top 20.

In his fourth year with Missouri, Welker's Tigers finished 17th in the national rankings and a third-place finish at the NCAA Gainesville Regional, only one spot shy of qualifying for the NCAA Championships. The 2017 season also saw Mizzou go 3-4 in Southeastern Conference dual meet action, with wins over No. 12 Arkansas, No. 12 Kentucky and No. 18 Auburn. The Tigers entered the season with just one SEC dual win in program history. Additionally, Missouri recorded the third and fourth-highest scores in program history in 2017, with a 197.200 against Auburn and a 197.150 one week later against Kentucky.

During the 2016 season, Welker led Mizzou to its highest NCAA Regional (third) finish since 2010. Overall, the Tigers finished the year ranked 19th in the national rankings, the team's highest since 2010, and ahead of Southeastern Conference foes Arkansas and Kentucky. Missouri recorded three scores of at least 196.625 or higher during the year in 2016, only the second time Mizzou accomplished that in the 37 year history of the program.

Additionally, the Tigers defeated No. 9 Georgia 195.800-195.350 for the team's first top-10 win since 2012. Under Welker's tutelage, freshmen Morgan Porter earned SEC Freshman of the Year honors and was the first Tiger gymnast to qualify for the NCAA Championships since 2012.

Under Welker's direction, the Tigers were the nation's most improved program in 2015. Mizzou finished the season ranked 21st, a full 20-spot increase from the previous year and the biggest jump in the country. The 2015 Tigers also qualified for their first NCAA championship since 2012, where they scored a 196.100, the second-best Regional score in program history. Additionally, Mizzou entered the top-25 for the first time since 2012 and scored at least 195 10 times in 13 meets. The Tigers also topped 196 twice during the season for the first time since 2012 as well.

In his first year in Columbia in 2014, Welker quickly installed his Championship Culture to the squad. Over the season, the Tigers went 6-7 in the regular season and scored the sixth-best bars score (49.300) in program history against George Washington.

Welker brought a wealth of experience to Columbia after five years as an assistant coach at the University of Michigan and nine years as the head coach and program director at the St. Louis Gymnastic Center. During his time at Michigan, Welker was primarily responsible for coaching the vault and floor squads in addition to serving as the recruiting coordinator. Welker guided his vault squads to three top ten finishes during his time at Michigan, and his 2012 vault team finished at No. 11 in the nation. Under his direction, the Michigan floor squads also finished among the nation's top-10 four times.

Welker coached five gymnasts to 12 All-American honors while at Michigan including the 2013 NCAA National Floor Champion, Joanna Sampson. He also produced three NCAA Regional Championship floor title winners and back-to-back NCAA Regional Champions on vault. Four of his gymnasts won event titles at the Big Ten Championships, and Welker assisted the Wolverines to three NCAA National Championships as well.

A four-year competitor on the University of Illinois at Chicago men's gymnastics team, Welker served as a team captain for three years and earned NCAA All-American honors in 1996. He was also awarded UIC Athlete of the Year honors that season. Welker was inducted into the University of Illinois at Chicago Athletics Hall of Fame in 2005.

Welker earned his undergraduate degree in kinesiology from the University of Illinois at Chicago in 1998, and also received his master's degree in sports management from Eastern Michigan University in 2012. Welker and his wife, Molly, have two sons, Ian and Brendan.

LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ The Mizzou gymnastics team fell to No. 1 Florida, 197.850-194.800 on Jan. 29 in Gainesville, Fla.
- ▶ The Tigers started strong with a season-high 49.050 on bars in the opening rotation. Sophomore **Sienna Schreiber** paced the squad with a 9.9, the highest score on the event for a Tiger this season. Freshman **Amaya Marshall** hit her routine for a career-best 9.85, while sophomore **Hollyn Patrick** and freshman **Jena Swanson** both went for 9.775s. Junior **Alisa Sheremeta** added a 9.75.
- ▶ A team-best 9.825 from Swanson on vault propelled the team to a 48.900 in the second rotation. Marshall also had a strong performance with a 9.8, and Schreiber and senior **Gabrielle Gottula** each had scores of 9.775. Vaulting for the first time in her career, Patrick recorded a 9.725.
- ▶ Marshall and Swanson scored identical 9.85s to lead the Tigers on floor in the third rotation. The score tied Swanson's personal-best, and marked Marshall's fourth-straight 9.8 or better score on the event to start her collegiate career. Schreiber and Sheremeta both had 9.8s, and Gottula added a 9.75. Overall, Mizzou went 49.050 as a team.
- ▶ Gottula opened Mizzou's beam rotation with a 9.875, a season-high for the senior. Sheremeta earned a 9.825 and junior **Hannah McCrary** went for a 9.75.

MISSOURI RANKED 28TH IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS

- ▶ Mizzou clocks in at 28th in this week's national rankings, with an average score of 195.038.
- ▶ The Tigers also rank 19th on floor, 23rd on bars, 40th on vault and 41st on beam.

MIZZOU GOES BIG ON FLOOR AGAINST KENTUCKY

- ▶ The Tigers closed the meet against Kentucky with a 49.250 on floor in the final rotation.
- ▶ The score marked the highest event total for the squad so far in 2021.
- ▶ All six Tigers scored at least a 9.8 in the floor rotation, including a 9.9 from junior **Hannah McCrary** and and 9.875 from junior **Alisa Sheremeta**.
- ▶ Before the 49.250, Mizzou's highest event score of the season was a 49.075, set on floor against Alabama on Jan. 15.

SCHREIBER NABS TWO TITLES AGAINST THE WILDCATS

- ▶ Sophomore **Sienna Schreiber** claimed both the bars and beam titles in Mizzou's meet against Kentucky on Jan. 22.
- ▶ She tallied scores of 9.875 on beam and 9.825 on bars to take top honors.
- ▶ The two wins here the second and third event titles of Schreiber's sophomore season, and the fourth and fifth of her Tiger career.
- ▶ Schreiber also won the beam crown at Georgia in the season opener.

MCCRARY CLAIMS FLOOR TITLE IN MEET VS. ALABAMA

- ▶ Junior **Hannah McCrary** anchored Mizzou's floor lineup with a 9.925 against Alabama on Jan. 15 to take the floor crown.
- ▶ The 9.925 tied her career-high, which she set at the Crimson Tide in 2020.
- ▶ It was the fourth event title of her career, and second on floor, as she also won the event in Mizzou's squad meet against Minnesota, Ohio State and Lindenwood a year ago.

NOTABLE NOTES

TIGERS SHOW IMPROVEMENT FROM FIRST MEET

- ▶ With a 195.750 against Alabama on Jan. 15, Mizzou improved its week one score by a full 1.5 points.
- ▶ The Tigers went 194.250 in the season opener on Jan. 8.
- ▶ The squad also improved event scores on three events against the Crimson Tide, going from 48.300 to 48.925 on vault, 48.100 to 48.825 on beam and 48.825 to 49.075 on floor.
- ▶ Mizzou's score was right on pace from week one, as the Tigers went 49.025 against Georgia and 48.925 against Alabama.

NEWCOMERS MAKE IMPACT IN SEASON OPENER

- ▶ A total of five Tigers made their collegiate debuts in Mizzou's meet at Georgia on Jan. 8.
- ▶ Overall, 10 of Mizzou's 22 routines against the GymDogs came from first-time gymnasts.
- ▶ Sophomores **Adalayna Hufendiek** and **Macy Orosco** and freshmen **Amaya Marshall**, **Sydney Schaffer** and **Jena Swanson** all saw their first action in a Tiger leo during the meet.
- ▶ Hufendiek did not compete as a freshman in 2020 after recovering from an injury suffered prior to her arrival in Columbia, and Orosco did not see any action during her freshman season at Alabama in 2020.
- ▶ Marshall (vault, bars, floor) and Swanson (vault, bars, floor) both competed three events in the opener, while Hufendiek (vault, bars) did two and Orosco (bars) and Schaffer (beam) each made one lineup.

SCHREIBER WINS BEAM TITLE AT GEORGIA

- ▶ Sophomore **Sienna Schreiber** anchored Mizzou's beam lineup with a career-high 9.9 on the apparatus in the season opener at Georgia on Jan. 8.
- ▶ As a freshman in 2020, Schreiber also won the all-around title against Florida and the bars title at the Mardi Gras Invite.
- ▶ The 9.9 bested Schreiber's previous high on the event of 9.85, which she scored twice last season.

TIGERS TO COMPETE IN SEC-ONLY SCHEDULE

- ▶ The Tigers, in conjunction with the Southeastern Conference, announced the 2021 schedule on Nov. 23
- ▶ The 2021 SEC gymnastics season will be comprised of eight meets per school over a 10-week conference-only schedule, with the regular-season concluding with the SEC Gymnastics Championships on March 20 in New Orleans.
- ▶ The decision to limit competition to conference-only opponents was based on the need for maximum flexibility in making any necessary scheduling adjustments while reacting to developments around the COVID-19 pandemic and continued advice from medical professionals.
- ▶ The schedule includes two open dates for all schools in Week five and Week 10 to allow for rescheduling of postponed events.

WHAT MIZZOU RETURNS

- ▶ Mizzou will have 63 percent of routines from a year ago available for the 2021 season.
- ▶ Sophomore **Sienna Schreiber** leads the team with 38 routines (out of a possible 40) from 2020
- ▶ Overall, Mizzou will have 68 percent of its floor lineup, 65 percent of its vault and beam and 55 percent of its bars lineup available for 2021.

NOTABLE NOTES

2020 SEASON AT A GLANCE

- ▶ The Tigers concluded the shortened 2020 season ranked 14th in the nation as it steadily climbed the rankings as year progressed.
- ▶ The Tigers' National Qualifying Score (NQS) of 196.635 at the time the season ended was the third-best such score in program history and the team's highest since 2004.
- ▶ Over the course of the season, Mizzou defeated No. 11 Minnesota and No. 19 Nebraska and twice posted team scores among the top 10 in program history.
- ▶ Two Tigers -- **Helen Hu** and **Sienna Schreiber** -- earned All-SEC honors, as Hu claimed SEC Event Specialist of the Year honors and spots on the All-SEC and SEC All-Freshman teams, and Schreiber made the All-Freshman team.
- ▶ Hu also claimed two WCGA All-America honors, with first team accolades on beam and second team honors on bars.
- ▶ On Feb. 14 Mizzou tied its all-time bars team score with a 49.400 at the Mardi Gras Invite, which matched the program record from the Texas Woman's Invite on March 12, 2004.
- ▶ Floor was a particular strength in 2020, especially the last six meets of the year, when Tigers averaged 49.288 over that span.
- ▶ A 196.850 at Alabama on Feb. 7 stood as the second-best road score in program history, trailing just the 197.475 set at the Texas Woman's Invite on March 12, 2004.

MISSOURI SET FOR SIX NATIONALLY TELEVISED MEETS IN 2021

- ▶ Mizzou will have six nationally televised meets in 2021
- ▶ The TV lineup features five regular season meets and the 2021 SEC Championship.
- ▶ Mizzou and Georgia kickoff the SEC Network's 2021 Friday Night Heights schedule on Friday, Jan. 8 with a 6 p.m. CT meet in Athens, Ga.
- ▶ The Tigers then return to SEC Network for consecutive meets in late January, as the home meet against Kentucky (Jan. 22) and an away contest at Florida (Jan. 29) will both be aired live on the network at 6 p.m. CT.
- ▶ The Feb. 12 and Feb. 19 meets against Auburn and Arkansas will also air live on SEC Network. Mizzou takes on Auburn at 8 p.m. CT on the 12th at the Hearn Center and travels to Fayetteville, Ark., to take on Arkansas on Feb. 19 at 7:30 p.m. CT.
- ▶ Mizzou's three regular season meets not picked up for TV, Jan. 15 against Alabama, Feb. 26 against Georgia and March 5 at LSU, will all broadcast live on SEC Network +.
- ▶ For the sixth consecutive year, the SEC Gymnastics Championship will be telecast live, with the 2021 edition airing exclusively on SEC Network. Coverage of the afternoon session starts at 2:30 p.m. CT with the evening session beginning at 7 p.m. CT.

FRESHMEN MADE AN IMPACT IN 2020

- ▶ Mizzou's 2020 freshmen class has made an impact last season.
- ▶ The freshmen made up 37.1 percent of the team's routines, with 89 of 240 total routines from the class.
- ▶ Overall, the 89 routines by the freshmen led the team in 2020, followed by 57 from the sophomore class, 54 from the senior class and 54 from the junior class.

SIX NEWCOMERS JOIN MISSOURI FOR THE 2021 CAMPAIGN

- ▶ The Mizzou squad features six newcomers, including five freshmen and one transfer, for the 2021 season.
- ▶ Sophomore transfer **Macy Orosco** joined the Tigers over the summer after spending her freshman year in 2020 at Alabama.
- ▶ The freshmen include **Kyra Burns** (Blue Springs, Mo.), **Amaya Marshall** (Kannapolis, N.C.), **Kalise Newson** (Golden, Colo.), **Sydney Schaffer** (Andover, Kan.) and **Jena Swanson** (Glendive, Mont.).
