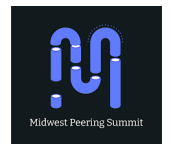

Information Security at ARIN

SOC 2 Type 1



ARIN completed the SOC 2 Type 1 audit of its Resource Public Key Infrastructure (RPKI) in December 2022

PCI DSS Certification



Finalizing PCI DSS certification of ARIN Online – to be completed this summer

Enhancements

Enhancements were made to existing security controls, including 2FA enhancements, new phishing defense tools and training

Risk & Cybersecurity Committee

ARIN established a Board Risk & Cybersecurity Committee

Routing Security

RPKI Adoption – Org Participation

- 19.5% of Orgs have registered to use ARIN's RPKI services (as of May 2023)

RPKI Valid Resources

- 45.3% of eligible ARIN IP resource announced are marked as RPKI valid

RPKI Partnerships in Action

Working with the **DNS Research Federation** on “RPKI Adoption and Routing Security in the ARIN region” (produced with funding support from the ARIN Community Grant Program)

Working with the other **Regional Internet Registries (RIRs)** for more unified maintenance of the RPKI data in conjunction with the Number Resource Organization (NRO)

RPKI Feature Improvements

No ROA signing requirement

- No more keys
- Simplified input
- Streamlined process

ROA auto-renew

- ROAs do not expire
- 90-day lifespan, renew at 10 days remaining
- True for Web IU and New API ROAs

New RESTful API

- 'Atomic' updates
- Multiple add/delete actions in one API call
- Legacy API still supported
- **Legacy API ROAs do not auto-renew**

As of 3 February 2023, ARIN's preexisting Specified Transfer Listing Service (STLS) and Facilitator Programs were suspended



A new Qualified Facilitators program is now available

Looking Ahead

Expiration of Annual Legacy Maintenance Fee Cap

As of 1 January 2024, ARIN will discontinue the application of a fee cap on annual Legacy maintenance fees for agreements formed after 31 December 2023.

The Fee Cap **will** continue for Legacy resources brought under an agreement before 1 January 2024.

ARIN Membership

Accorded automatically when you receive a direct allocation of IP address space.



Service Members

Entities that have a valid ARIN Registration Services Agreement (RSA or LRSA) for IPv4 and/or IPv6 address space



General Members

Have the same RSA or LRSA as Service Members, but have committed to participate in ARIN elections

2023 ARIN Elections

ARIN Board of Trustees – 4 open seats

ARIN Advisory Council – 5 open seats

NRO NC – 1 appointee

Any individual may submit a self-nomination for the Board of Trustees and Advisory Council – www.ARIN.net/elections

Who can vote?

To be eligible, an ARIN General member must be in Good Standing and have designated a Voting Contact

2023 ARIN Elections Timeline



16 June - Opening of Call for Nominations

30 June - Closing of Call for Nominations

4 September - Deadline to establish Voter Eligibility for Voting Contacts

5 September - Initial slate of Candidates announced

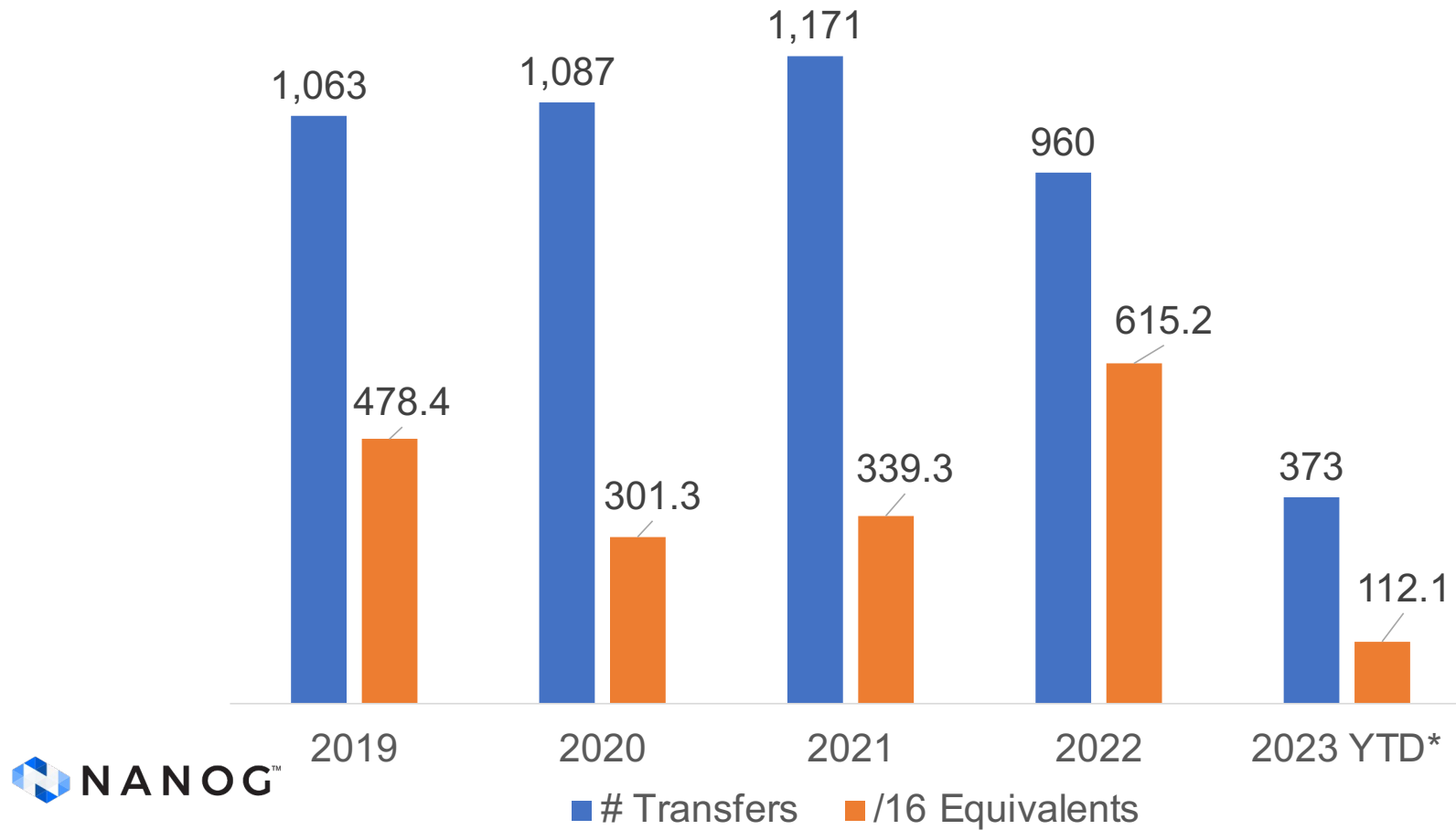

4 October - Final Slate of 2023 candidates announced

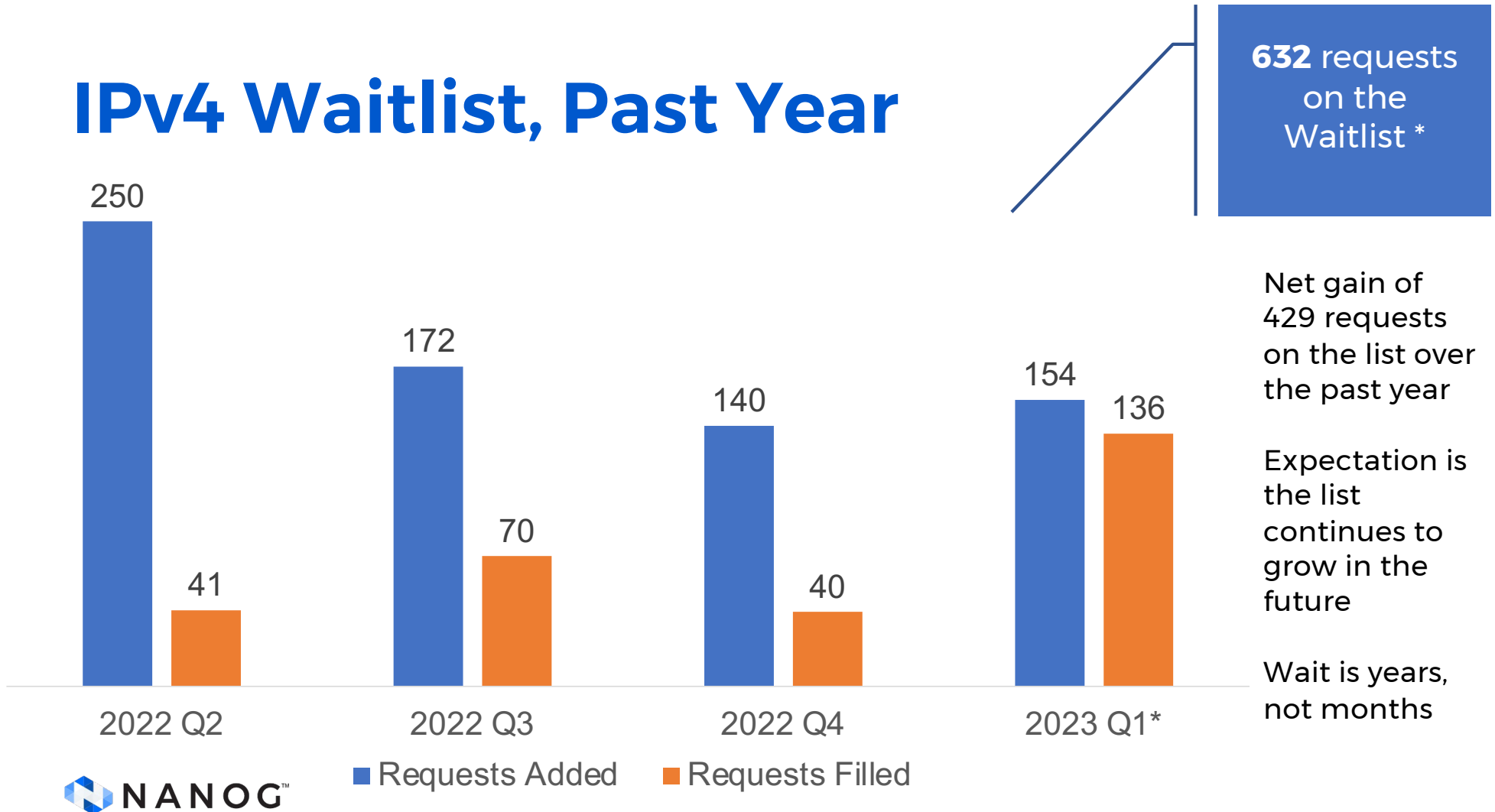
