A petition from sundry
citizens living in Green County + Campbell Township
for a public road from Springfield to the upper
Pools on the Hasconade, to intersect the Farmington
road, being presented, and this court having taken
into consideration its utility to the public, and to
Green County in particular, it is ordered by the court
here that the said petition be granted, and the
following men are hereby appointed to view the
same, William Rice, William Brown, + Solomon Potter.

Ordered by the court here that Jacob Roles be appointed
overseer of the road No 1 on the Arkansas road which
district extends from the Post house in Springfield to
the house of James Wilson, at or near the Delaware Town.

This day came Whaley Canfield collector for the
County of Green for the year 1885 and presented to
the Court a receipt from D. D. Berry, County Treasurer
for the county of Green, for Three Hundred and ninety
dollars + sixty 1/2 cents. It is ordered by the court here
that said collector be credited with said amount, and
the said Treasurer be charged with the same.

The court now proceeded to appoint the following men
a patrol for Campbell Township, who shall be bound to
patrol twelve hours in each month, Thomas Core, Captain
James A. McCarroll, Joseph Bruden, John McCall and
Samuel Freeman.

On motion it is ordered by the Court here that Christopher
Olmore, administrator of James Fitzhugh, deceased, be permitted
to remove the papers of the said administrator to Benton
County, and the Clerk of this court is ordered to give
him a transcript of all the papers appertaining to
the said estate. Court then adjourned until tomorrow
at 10 o'clock

The court now proceeded to lay off road districts on the State road passing through the county of Census District No 1 extending from the Court house in the Town of Springfield to Wilsons Creek on the State road in the direction to the Arkansas Line, including all the settlements east of the Old road to Delaware Town and south of the Court house, including James Langford, Lemoy, Kidd Patterson & the Roler Settlement

It is ordered by the court here that William Dye be and is hereby appointed overseer of road district No 1, and the clerk is ordered to issue a certificate of his appointment.

Ordered by the court here that the road from Wilson creek, on the State road, to Barrie County line constitute road district No 2, including all hands liable to work on public roads, including & from Archibald Raines down the James, including the Delaware Town, thence to the mouth of the Cindy, thence up Cindy as far as Jarvis Jones. It is further ordered that Robert Forbes be and is hereby appointed overseer of road district No 2, and the clerk is hereby ordered to issue a certificate of said appointment.

Ordered by the court here that the State road from the Court house in the Town of Springfield, to the near edge of Robinson prairie, constitute road district No 3 including all the hands liable to work on public roads from the court house, all west of Bonville road, also including D. B. Miller, C. Hendrix, Joseph Hall, and the Roler Settlement, as far as C. Batters. It is further ordered that Gabriel Whetton be and is hereby
