 1838-39

- Feb. 20- Court House out of town, jail burned down, two brick churches, four taverns, 5 or 6 good stores, neat buildings, wood, painted (Potosi)
 Feb. 21- Became acquainted with Mr. Milam-Merchant, also James H. Havenwkh who is trying to get an English School. Stayed at White Hall.
 X Feb. 22- Paid bill, put off for Caledonia 12 miles South. Belleview Settlement country of good land, camped at Seburns 2 mi. W. of Caledonia. (Jas. Seburn, Sec. 9, T35 R2E, Washington Co.)
 Feb. 23- To Harmony, Cotoway Lead Mines near Jesse Murphys (T36 R1W) 55 mi.
 X Feb. 24- To Huzzard Cr. Brickeys, Sec. 20-21, T36 R1W 12 mi. (Crawford Co.) 125 miles from where we crossed the Mississippi.
 Feb. 25- To Prestly Andersons on Dry Creekn (10 mi. ?)
 X Feb. 26- To Davis near Steelville (T38 R4W) 10 mi.
 X Feb. 27- To Brinkers near Masseys Sec. 5 T37 R5W Crawford Co. 10 mi.
 X Feb. 28- To Mr. Wishon Sec. 34, T37 R7W (Wishon Cem.) 11 mi. (Phelps Co.)
 Mar. 1- To Wilsons on Beaver Cr. passed complete desert. T36 R8W (Phelps Co) 12 mi. (desert Little Prairie)
 X Mar. 2- To Bates, 1 1/2 mi. below Bates on Little Piney (Sec. 19 ?) T37 R9W, Phelps Co. Mrs. Thompson came up to camp, husband Johnston T. died at Potosi.
 Mar. 3- Detachment didn't move. Lewis Ross returned.
 Mar. 4- James Harrison 2 mi. below Bates a mean man, will not let any person connected with emigration stay with him.
 Mar. 4- To Harrisons on Big Piney Sec. 24, T37 R10W, Phelps Co. (10 mi.) Very cold.
 X Mar. 5- To Waynesville on Roberdeau Cr. at Col. Swiks., Sec. 25-30, T36 R11-12. Pulaski Co. 12 mi.
 Mar. 6- To Starks on Gasconade, Pulaski Co. ? 14 mi.
 Mar. 7- Beans on Osage Fork. Moses Bean Postmaster Onyx, 1837. Pulaski Co. Traveled 10 mi.
 Mar. 8- To Grigsbys 10 mi. (McCormick-Barney BIGSBY Sec. 3, T33 R16W Laclede.
 X Mar. 9- To creek 4 mi. from Parks. Park(e) Postmaster Gave Spring 1837, " Co. Traveled 10 mi. ? (Laclede Co.)
 Mar. 10 Detachment came up to Burnetts early. Butrick preached HILL DE BRAND - ANOTHER ROAD - TO OVERTAKE U.S.
 Mar. 11- Off early, 10 mi. to Neavis. ? (South of Northview, Webster Co.)
 X Mar. 12- to Danforths NE of Springfield, Greene Co. (6 mi. NE-McCormick) 12 mi.
 X MAR. 13- Snowing. Came on to Springfield 8 mi. (Mar. 13)
 X Mar. 14- To Dye(r) Dyes, 12 mi. (Bells Tavern) T37 R24W, Christian Co.
 X Mar. 15- Through a desert to Allens, 11 mi. T25 R24W, Stone Co. 2 mi NW-Crane.
 X Mar. 16- To Lock(e)s on Flat Cr. of White R. 12 mi. T24 R26W, Barry Co.
 X Mar. 17- Up Flat Cr. to McMurtres, 15 mi. T21 R28W, Barry Co.
 Mar. 18- To Pratts through Washburns Prairie, 18 mi. Crossed Arkansas line near Meeks on Sugar Cr.
 Mar. 19- Rain all day, did not travel.
 X Mar. 20 mi. to the X hollows, came 5 mi. to Fitzgeralds, eat at Homeslys.
 Y Mar. 21- Passed through Fayetteville, met detachment at Cunninghams, 3 mi. Fayetteville in Washington Co. Ark. (eat at the Brick tavern)
 Mar 22- To Col. Thomasons 16 mi.
 Mar. 23- Arrived at Woodalls in Cherokee Nation West 3 mi. from line.
 Mar. 24- Most of Indians turned over to Gov't., settled my business.
 Mar. 25- Left for John Ross Hdq. down Barren Fork of Illinois and over to Main River, took lodging at Wm. Keys. Jim Brown there.

- Feb. 23- Traveled to Harmony, Cotoway Lead Mines, camped near Jesse Murphy
- Feb. 24- Camped on Huzzard Creek a branch of the Merrimack, 125 miles from where we crossed the Mississippi. 3 MI.
- Feb. 25- Traveled to Prestly Andersons on Dry Creek.
- Feb. 26- Traveled to Davis near Steelville, 3 miles.
- Feb. 27- Traveled 10 miles to Brinker near Massys Iron Works. Examined for
- Feb. 28- Traveled to Mr. Wishon, 11 miles.
- Mar. 1 - Detachment traveled 12 miles to Wilsons, complete desert, camped on Bever Creek.
- Mar. 2 - Mrs. Thompson came to camps, husband Johnston Thompson died at Potosi. Det. moved 1 1/2 mi. below Bates on Little Piney.
- Mar. 3 - Detachment didn't move. Lewis Ross returned.
- Mar. 4 - James Harrison 2 miles below Bates a mean man, will not let any person connected with emigration stay with him.
- Mar. 5 - Traveled to Harrison's on Big Starke's on Gasconade R. 14 MI
- Mar. 5 - Traveled 12 miles to Waynesville on Roberdeau Creek, branch of Gasconade. MAR 6 - STARK'S ON GAS. R. PULASKI CO 14 MI
- Mar. 7 - Encamped at Beans on Osage Fork at 10 am. 10 miles.
- Mar. 8 - Traveled to Grigsbys 10 miles.
- Mar. 9 - Traveled 11 miles to creek 4 miles SW of Parks, Parks 7 mi.
- Mar. 10- Detachment came up to Burnetts early, BUTTRICK preached
- Mar. 11- Off early 10 miles to Neavis.
- Mar. 12- 12 miles to Danforths, snowing.
- Mar. 13- Cold. Came on to Springfield 8 miles
- Mar. 14- Traveled to Dyer (Bell Tavern) 12 miles.
- Mar. 15- Traveled 17 miles to Allens, through a desert.
- Mar. 16- Traveled 12 miles to Locks in Barry County on Flat Cr, White River
- Mar. 17- Traveled up Flat Creek 15 miles to McMurtres.
- Mar. 18- Traveled through Washburns Prairie to Pratt's 18 miles. Crossed Arkansas line near Meeks on Sugar Cr. 7 miles NE of Pratt's.

- Mar. 21- Passed through Fayetteville, met detachment at Cunninghams 3 mi

- Mar. 23- Arrived at Woodalls in Cherokee Nation West 3 mi. from boundary
- Mar. 24- Most of Indians turned over to Gov't., settled my business.
- Mar. 25- Left for John Ross Hdq. down Barren Fork of Illinois and over to Main River, took lodging at Wm. Keys. Jim Brown there.
